

## Get to Know Key2SafeDriving™

This section describes how to see some of the features of the Key2SafeDriving™ solution. These options are accessed while the phone is in Safe Driving Mode.

### Manage Profile

1. Select the Options menu in the lower right corner.
2. Type the PIN you entered during installation.
3. Select Manage Profile.
4. Select Emergency Contacts to change Emergency Contact Numbers. The first Emergency Contact number is also the administrative contact. This number will receive text notifications from the phone.
5. Select Change PIN. This is where you can change the administrative PIN.
6. Exit back to Safe Driving Mode screen.

## Get to Know Key2SafeDriving™

### Emergency Calling

1. Select Emergency Dialing from the menu.
2. Select one of the optional emergency numbers. The phone will call that number.
3. Hang up.

Calls to the phone from either of the optional Emergency Contacts are always permitted through.

*(Note: If the user calls 911, the Key2SafeDriving will allow all incoming calls for the next three hours. This feature is to comply with Public Safety Answering Point (911 emergency service) recommendations.)*

### End Safe Driving Mode

1. Turn off the car.
2. In about 30 seconds the phone will drop out of Safe Driving Mode and you will be able to use the phone.

## Key2SafeDriving is Easy to Install

The typical installation takes less than five minutes, and is accomplished in two parts:

1. First, install the Key2SafeDriving™ phone software.
2. Second, install the Key2SafeDriving™ Activator® in your car.

### Mobile Phone Requirements

- Blackberry 4.5 or above, Symbian S60 3rd edition or above, or Windows Mobile 6.x or above
- Bluetooth
- 8 Mbytes of free storage space
- Texting plan (average user can expect to send roughly 100 messages a month)
- Optional: Internet data plan (simplifies installation)

## 1. Install Phone Software

We recommend that a parent does this portion of the installation

### To Install the Key2SafeDriving™ Software

1. From your web browser, go to [www.SafeDrivingSystems.com/software](http://www.SafeDrivingSystems.com/software).
2. Follow the instructions on the site.

*(Note: During the installation, you will be asked for a PIN and an Administrative Phone Number. The PIN is used to access the administrative features of Key2SafeDriving. The phone number is the primary contact for emergencies and other notifications. This number should be able to receive text messages.)*

## 2. Install Activator®

The Key2SafeDriving™ Activator® is designed to be a "Plug and Forget" device. Once installed, you should never need to worry about it again.

### To Install the Activator®

1. Locate the OBD II port under the dash of your car.
2. Plug Activator® into the OBD II port.

*(Note: The OBD II port should be located under the dashboard on the driver's side of the vehicle. It should be within 18" of the front seat. Some vehicles may hide the OBD II port behind an access panel or underneath a coin tray.)*

## 3. Verify the Installation

### To Verify the Key2SafeDriving™ Installation

1. Take your phone to the car with the Activator®.
2. Start the car. The phone will start Safe Driving Mode in 30 seconds.
3. To stop Safe Driving Mode simply turn off your car.
