

Clarification letter: July 5th 2016

Runcom TVWS CPE (FCC ID: XYMCPETVWS-1)

In order to ensure that Runcom TVWS devices are connected to an authorized AFAS and not other software pretending to be AFAS or other management software, the following measures have been taken.

- 1- In order to operate the TVWS system (Base Station and CPEs), the System must be configured to a TVWS channel.
- 2- The only way operators can configure the TVWS channel is via the AFAS software (see explanation in the email from Runcom to the FCC from June 28, 2016)
- 3- The AFAS is provided to the operators by Runcom under license and no unauthorized copies of AFAS will be available


As a result of the above, the only way to operate the Runcom TVWS system is by using the AFAS software. Because operators will have only an authorized copy of AFAS, the Commission can be assured that the TVWS system will be operated **only** via authorized AFAS software.

Furthermore, the Runcom TVWS System is operated only by authorized professional installers. The installers are instructed in the CPE manual page ii (Attached) as follows:

Note: THE CPE-O-R-WS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE OPERATED ONLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE AFAS SOFTWARE THAT CONNECTS THE CPE TO THE TWWS DATA BASE

In summary, there is no way to operate the TVWS system without the AFAS. Operators will have only authorized (licensed) AFAS and the professional installers are instructed to operate the TVWS system only with the AFAS. We therefore believe that there is no possibility for the Runcom TVWS system to be operated by an unauthorized AFAS or any other managing software.
