


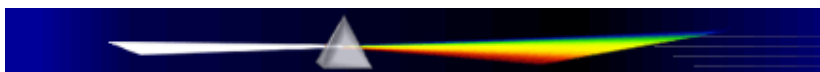

In other words, the battery cover cannot be removed from the EUT and will always be attached to the EUT.
