According to the FCC document:

**“PROCEDURES FOR SALE, MERGER OR TRANSFER IN CONTROL OF COMPANY (GRANTEE)”**

ACTION - Company B buys (or merges with) Company A's assets, buildings, tooling equipment, whatever. Procedure 2 - Company B must file an application for each device that they want to market. Each application will be a Change in FCC ID filing in accordance with Section 2.933(b) of the FCC Rules. Company B pays only one fee for all these applications per Section 2.929(d). The fee is the most expensive fee of only one of all the equipment classes of the devices that they want to market.

The FCC ID under which the required fee (EFT (Type approval = **615US\$**)) must be paid is **YDAECELL**.
