“Close Date” as defined as follows: As you may be aware, Nortel Networks Limited and various of its affiliates filed voluntary petitions for insolvency protection in various jurisdictions, including under the CCAA and Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. In connection with these filings, on November 24, 2009, Nortel Networks Limited and various of its affiliates (“**Nortel**”) executed an asset sale agreement (the “**Asset Sale Agreement**”) with Kapsch CarrierCom AG, a corporation organized under the laws of Austria (“**Kapsch**”) for the sale of its GSM business (the “**Business**”), and the transaction was approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice and the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (collectively, the “**Bankruptcy Courts**”) on December 2, 2009.

The closing of the sale of the Business pursuant to the Asset Sale Agreement is expected to occur on or before March 31.
