During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, rotating the turntable, varying antenna height from 1m to 4m in both horizontal and vertical polarizations. The emissions worst-case are shown in Test Results of the following pages. Duty cycle setting during the transmission is 100% with maximum power setting for all modulations.

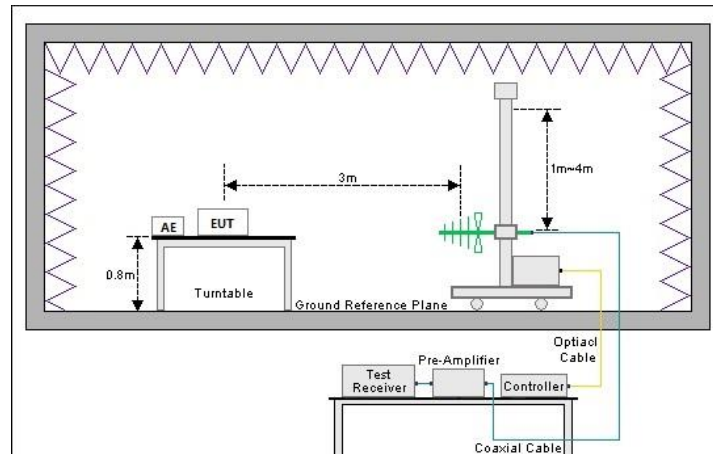

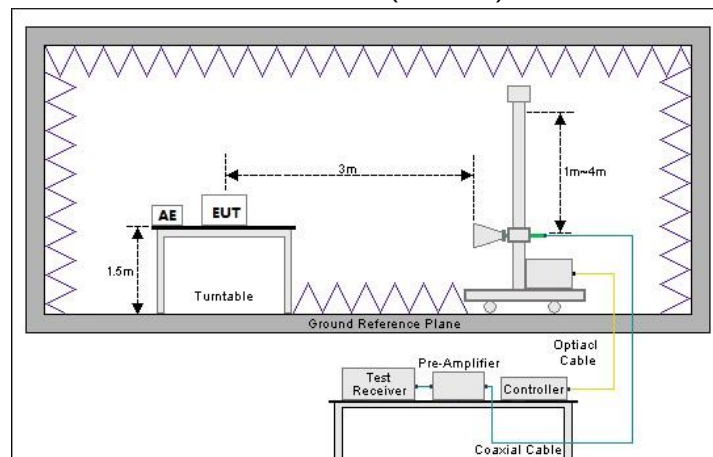

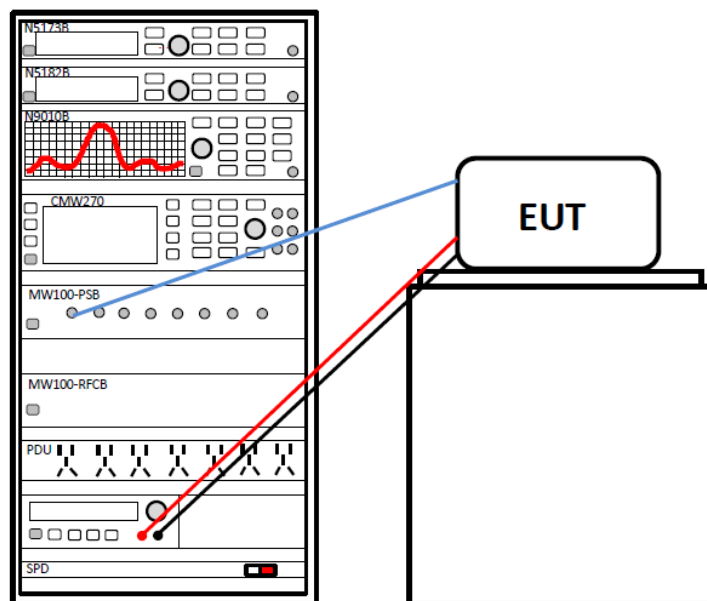
Below 1GHz (3m SAC)

4.3 Test Procedure

Test method	Test step
Radiated emission	For below 1GHz: 1. The EUT was placed on the tabletop of a rotating table 0.8 m the ground at a 3 m semi anechoic chamber. The measurement distance from the EUT to the receiving antenna is 3m . 2. EUT works in each mode of operation that needs to be tested , and having the EUT continuously working, respectively on 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position. The highest signal levels relative to the limit shall be determined by rotating the EUT from 0° to 360° and with varying the measurement antenna height between 1 m and 4 m in vertical and horizontal polarizations. 3. Open the test software to control the test antenna and test turntable. Perform the test, save the test results, and export the test data. For above 1GHz: 1. The EUT was placed on the tabletop of a rotating table 1.5 m the ground at a 3 m fully anechoic room. The measurement distance from the EUT to the receiving antenna is 3 m. 2. EUT works in each mode of operation that needs to be tested , and having the EUT continuously working, respectively on 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position. The highest signal levels relative to the limit shall be determined by rotating the EUT from 0° to 360° and with varying the measurement antenna height between 1 m and 4 m in vertical and horizontal polarizations. 3. Open the test software to control the test antenna and test turntable. Perform the test, save the test results, and export the test data.
Conducted test method	1. The ZigBee antenna port of EUT was connected to the test port of the test system through an RF cable. 2. The EUT is keeping in continuous transmission mode and tested in all modulation modes. 3. Open the test software, prepare a test plan, and control the system through the software. After the test is completed, the test report is exported through the test software.
