Subject: Correction of Equipment Class of YEY-V3-1005A

For the original application for YEY-V3-1005A submitted on 3/10/2021, the applicant used the list of equipment classes available from the FCC website and felt that DXT was the closest fit for their device.

While reviewing the application, the reviewer determined based on the fact that historically DXT was for transceivers and DXX was for transmitters without a receiver that DXT was the appropriate classification.

Reviewers are trained to use the official resources available to them rather than rely on memory. Given the equipment class was still showing as a valid option on the FCC website and was also consistent with historic practice, it was accepted as the equipment class on this application.

Subsequently, when the first C2PC was filed on 3/10/2022, it was checked to make sure the same equipment class was chosen as it had to match the original. Afterwards, at the April 2022 TCB conference the FCC mentioned that DXT was being expired and the EAS was modified to remove DXT as an option for future filings.

At this time, Intertek would like to request putting both of these applications into audit mode in order to upload this document and the request the FCC to change the equipment class on both to DXX.
