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**IMPORTANT:** Please adjust screen to make the touching effect function best when you initiate the unit for the first time.

For the details, please refer to the operation at Page 13.

**NOTE:** Due to the continuous product improvement, specifications and design are subject to change without prior notice.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

### ***Notes on Installation***

The unit is designed for 12VDC,negative ground operation system only. Before installing the unit, make sure your vehicle is connected to DC12V negative ground system.

Be sure to connect the color coded leads according to the diagram.Incorrect connections may cause the unit to malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.

Be sure to connect the speaker (-) leads to the speaker (-) terminal.

Never connect the left and right channel speaker cables each other or to the vehicle body.

Make sure all the connections are completely correct before turning on your unit. When replacing the fuse(s), the re-placement must be of the same amperage as shown on the fuse holder.

Do not block vents or radiator panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.

After completing the installation and beginning to play the unit (including replacing the battery),please remove the guard against theft front-panel at first, and then press **RESET** button on the base with pointed object (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

**NOTE: The unit is compatible with VCD1.0/2.0/3.0 version and DVCD disc.**

\*Do not attempt to modify the unit, modifying the unit may cause an accident.

\*Stop the vehicle before carrying out any operation that could interfere with your driving.

\*Do not work in extremely high or low temperature. Be sure the temperature inside the vehicle is between +60° C and -10° C before turning on your unit.

\*To enjoy optimum sound and images while playing, handle the discs as follows:

—Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.




—Do not use your CDs with paste residue or ink attached.



—Do not use CDs with labels or stickers attached, which may leave a sticky residue while beginning to peel off. (Shown as the picture)




—Clean the discs with an optional cleaning cloth. Wipe each disc from the center out. (Shown as the picture)

## **FRONT PANEL**

- 1.REL:Press to open the guardagainst theft front-panel.
- 2.VOL:Rotate VOL button clock wiseto increase the volume level; and rotate VOL button anticlockwise to decrease the volume level.  
Press the button to select one of the audio control:L-front/R-front/L-rear/R-rear/Subwoofer/Bass/Middle/Treble/TILT/Volume.  
Rotate the button to adjust the selecteditem
- 3.◀◀/◀/▶/▶▶ :In radio mode, long press switches to manual seek station .  
Short press switches to automatic.  
In playback mode, short press to select previous or next track or chapter.  
Long press will perform fast reverse or fast forward.
- 4.▶⏸/BAND: Press to pause or play playback mode.  
In radio mode, press to change current band.
- 5.SRC: Press to switch sources.
- 6.POWER/MUTE:Press to turn on the unit, press and hold the button for 1 second or longer to turn off the unit. In power on, press to shut off the sound output, press it again to resume previous sound.
- 7.A/V IN: Insert the A/V cord, then press PWR/SRC button to selectAUX1 source.
- 8.SD slot: Insert SD card, the unit will play the files of SD card automatically.  
NOTE: Once the SD card could not eject automatically after pressing, just pull it out manually .
- 9.USB slot: Insert USB device, the unit will play the files of USB automatically.
10. IR window
11. ▲:Short press to eject a disc.
12. OPEN: Press to open or close the TFT panel.
13. DISP/AF: in radio mode, press to turn the AF function on/offpress and hold to display the current time ,source of the front and rear display and media (Disc,USB,SD)available.
14. MIC
15. TA: In radio mode, press to turn the TA function on /off
16. PTY: press to switch PTY program type
17. RESET: press to return to the initialization
18. ⌂/⌂(TILT):Press to set the angle of TFT panel.
19. MENU:In DVD mode, press to display DVD SETUP menu;  
Long press or press in other mode to display SYSTEM SETUP menu.

The users can perform operation by touching screen directly.

**Radio Operation****1. BACKLIGHT**

Turn on /off the backlight.

(The function can be used to change the screen brightness while travelling at night)

To display the SOURCE screen

**3. Station preset button**

To display the preset station list

(touch one of the station preset button to recall the radio which stored on the position;  
long touch to save the current frequency into the station)

**4.BAND**

To switch bands.

**5.LOC**

To select strong or weak stations reception

**6.EQ**

To select a preset equalizer mode.

**7.LOUD**

To switch LOUD control function on/off

**8.PAGE 1**

To switch to RDS operation page.(Refer to “RDS Operation” for detail)

**9.SEEK-/SEEK+**

To seek a station automatically,



### 1.TA

To turn on /off TA function

### 5.SEEK-/SEEK+

To seek a station automatically.

To seek a station manually(long touch).

### EON(Enhanced Other Networks)

**ON:** Active the EON function, the receiver automatically tunes in the station that broadcasts the traffic information when it occurs, After broadcasted ,the unit will automatically return to the original source play before the traffic information broadcast began.

**OFF:** Deactive the EON function

### REG(Regional)

**ON:** Active the REG function, the unit automatically keeps receiving the related RDS station.

**OFF:** Deactive the REG function

## Multi-- Player Operation

In DVD mode, the touching screen display as following after touching at random position.



**1.PLAY**

To start the playback.

**2.PAUSE**

To pause the playback.

**3.STOP**

To stop playing, touch twice to stop completely.

**4.MENU**

To display the DVD SETUP screen.

**5.PREV/NEXT**

To select previous/next chapter or tracks.

**NOTE: Touching the left middle position twice to display the TITLE MENU selection screen, touching the right middle position twice to display the ROOT MENU selection screen, touching the right top position to display the number keyboard. You can select chapter(track) by pressing the touchable screen or the RC.**





**Setup Operation**

*TOUCH ON THE TOP LEFT POSITION TO ENTER SOURCE INTERFACE.*

*The unit will return to previous mode display screen if any operation is not perform in 5 s.*



**1.Front**

To display the source selection screen.



Touch the item to select source displayed on the unit screen.

**2.Rear**

To select a source which display on the rear monitor



\* It is unavailable in AUX or TV mode.

\* If another monitor(rear)is connected to the unit,image/audio of the rear monitor can be changed from the unit,so you can enjoy separate image/audio in the rearseats.

\* The unit will output corresponding source sound through REAR-VIDEO-OUT or DUAL-AUDIO-OUT

**3.Audio**


Touch on the AUDIO button and the screen will display as following:



In this menu, there are items of Volume, L-front,R-fornt, L-rear, R-rear , Subwoof, Bass, Middle and Treble can be adjusted. Touch on the  $\blacktriangle$   $\triangleright$  button to adjust each item and touch on  $\blacktriangle$   $\blacktriangledown$  button to turn pages and select the item listed above.

**4.Video**

Press on the VIDEO button and the screen will display as following:



In this menu, there are items of Bright, Hue, Contrast, Sharp can be adjusted. Touch on the item that need adjusted then touch on the   button to adjust.

**5.SYSTEM**

To display the system setup screen. *Refer to “system setup operation” for detail*

**6.EXIT**

To return to current source screen.

Set the time display mode(12H/24H)

**Key Beep**

Turn on/off the sound guide function

ON:activate the sound guide mode

OFF:deactivate the sound guide mode.

The sound guide beep will not be produced when a button on the unit is pressed.

**Local Area**

Touch the provided option to change the radio frequency for different country.



Touch the provided option to adjust the bass freq, middle freq, treble freq.



Touch the provided option to change the subwoofer ,the bass and middle quality factor.



#### **Clock Adjust**

Adjust the time by touch ⇠ ⇢ ⇣ ⇤

#### **Night Lum (dimmer)--in half-night mode**


The function to select the backlight brightness.(normal status's 20%,40%,60%,80% )

#### **Touch Adjust**

When the display position on the screen and the touch position on the touch panel not match, or using the product at first time, the adjustment becomes necessary.



Accurately touch the mark provided in the screen for more than 2 seconds until the “adjust succeed” is displayed .

## REMOTE CONTROL

### **Installing the battery**

Slide the tray out on the back of the remote control and insert the battery with the plus (+) and minus (-) poles pointing in the proper direction.



### **Use and care of the remote control**

Point the remote control in the direction of the front panel to operate to use it.

#### **Notes:**

Using batteries improperly can cause them to explode. Take note of the following points:

- \* Keep the battery out of the reach of children. Should the battery be swallowed, immediately consult a doctor.
- \* Use one CR2025(3V)lithium battery.
- \* Remove the battery if the remote control is not to be used for a month or longer.
- \* Do not short-circuit, disassemble or heat batteries.
- \* Do not dispose of batteries into fire or flames.
- \* Dispose of spent batteries properly.
- \* Do not let the remote control fall onto the floor, where it may become jammed under the brake or accelerator pedals.

**REMOTE CONTROL****1. POWER/**

Press the button to turn on the unit;Press and hold for 1second or longer to turn off the unit. In power on,press to mute the device. Press it again to resume previous sound level.

**2. EQ/**

Press to select the corresponding preset modes to adjust the sound quality.

In bluetooth mode, press this button to dial up a call.

**3. ANGLE/AMS**

Press to change the viewing angle in DVD mode;In radio mode, press to browse each stored station .Long press to scan and store station automatically.

In TV mode, long press the button to scan and store channel automatically, press it again to stop scanning.

**4. SUB-T/LOC**

In DVD playback mode, press to change the subtitle language;In radio mode, press to select strong or weak station reception.

**5. PROG/A-B**

In DVD/VCD/CD mode, press to set the program order to play;In playback mode, press and hold to play the section of selected chapter/track repeatedly .

**6. OSD/\***

In playback mode, press to display the playback information; In other mode, press to display the current time, the set source output through the front and rear display, the current available drive.(Disc/SD/USB);In bluetooth mode, press to function as\* button on your mobile phone functions .

**7. GOTO/#**

In DVD mode, press the button and the cursor button to select TITLE、CHAPTER、AUDIO、SUBTITLE、ANGLE、TT TIME、CH TIME、REPEAT、TIME DISP.Then press ENTER button to set the value.

In VCD mode, press GOTO button and cursor button to select TRACK、DISC TIME、TRACK TIME、REPEAT、TIME DISP.Then press ENTER button to set.

In CD/MP3 mode, press GOTO button to select "Disc Go To:\_:\_:\_"、"Track Go To \_:\_:\_:\_"、"Select Track:\_:\_:xx". Then press 0-9 number buttons to set the track you want.

In bluetooth mode, press this button to function as # button on your mobile phone functions .

In radio mode ,press the button and the number button to set the frequency.

In TV mode ,press the button and the number button to select a channel

**8. MENU**

Press to return to the root menu in DVD mode.

In radio mode,press to switch between radio main screen and RDS screen.

**9. [◀◀ / ▶▶][▲/▼/◀/▶]/ENTER**

In playback mode perform [fast reverse/fast forward][previous track/next track][upwards/downwards/leftwards/rightwards]; press ENTER to validate.

**10. RPT**

In playback mode, press to select a repeat mode.

**11、II▶ /PTY**

In radio mode, press this button to switch to RDS program type.  
In DVD/VCD mode, press to play slowly

**12、ZOOM/AF**

In radio mode, press this button to function AF on/off.  
In DVD/VCD mode, press to increase or decrease the picture in size.

**13、SRC/IR-SW**

Press the button repeatedly to switch sources. Press and hold this button to change the IR to control front or rear source. (\*It is disable when rear source shut off.)

**14、VOL-/SEL/VOL+**

Press VOL-/VOL+ to adjust volume.  
Press SEL to select one of the control item:L-front/R-front/L-rear/R-rear/Subwoof/Bass/Middle/Treble/Angle/Volume. Then press VOL+/- to adjust each item.

**15、▲**

Press to eject a disc

**16、LOUD/♪**

Press this button to activate LOUD function.  
In bluetooth mode, press this button to hand down your calling.

**17、(0-9)NUMBER BUTTON**

In radio(TV) mode, press the number button to select a corresponding preset station (channel)  
In DVD/VCD/CD mode, press to select any chapter or track directly.  
In bluetooth mode, press to input the telephone number.

**18、CLEAR**

Press the button to clear the erroneous number what you import.

**19、▶||**

Press to pause playing and press again to resume playing.

**20、TITLE**

In DVD mode, press the button to return the title menu.  
In VCD mode, press this button to turn on/off PBC function.

**21、■**

Press to stop playback.

**22、BAND/P/N**

In radio mode, press to select bands.  
In DVD/VCD mode, press P/N button to select PAL, AUTO or NTSC.

**23、SETUP**

In playback mode, short press to display DVD setting, long press in DVD mode and press in other modes will display system settings.

**24、AUDIO/ST**

In DVD mode, press to change the audio language.  
In VCD mode, press to change the channel mode.  
In radio mode, press to select stereo or mono reception.

**25、RDM/TA**

In radio mode, press this button to function TA on/off.  
In playback mode, press to play tracks in a random order.

## BASIC OPERATION

### 1. Reset the Unit

Operating the unit for the first time or after replacing the car battery, you must reset the unit. Press RESET button on the head unit with a pointed object, (such as a ballpoint pen) to set the unit to initial status.

\*This function can only be operated by the head unit.

### 2. Turning the Unit On/Off

Press PWR/  button on the remote control to turn on the unit. N unit ON, when insert a disc, the unit will automatically start playing. Long press it to turn off the unit completely. *Pressing POWER/MUTE button on the front panel also performs the same operation.*

#### Note:

After the unit is off, the volume level is memorized during the area between 0 and 30. If it is set less than 6, it will resume to 6; if the set volume level is higher than 30, it will resume to 30; if it is between 6 and 30, it still stores in the status which you set.

### 3. Volume Control

Press VOL+ button on the remote control to increase the sound level and press VOL- button on the remote control to decrease the sound level.

*Press (VOL+ or VOL-) on the front panel also performs the same operation.*

### 4. Setting the Sound Characteristics

Repeatedly press SEL button or press SEL button on the remote control to select the desired mode in the following order:



#### Note:

\* After selecting the desired mode, you can adjust the current level by press the-/+ button or pressing VOL-/VOL+ buttons on the remote control.

\* after adjusting the Angle item, the unit will memorize the angle of the panel.

\* If you don't adjust VOL button in 3 seconds after selecting the desired mode, the function will be cancel.


### 5. Mute Function

Press PWR/  button to shut off the sound output. "MUTE" will be displayed on the screen. Press it again to resume to previous volume level.

*Press PWR/MUTE button on the panel also performs the same operation.*

### 6. EQ Setting

While listening to the popular music, classic music or rock music, you can select the corresponding preset modes to adjust the sound quality perfectly by using EQ button on the remote control. Repeatedly pressing EQ button to choose the following modes in turn:



## RADIO OPERATION

Selecting the radio mode, the TFT display as the follow:



### 1. Band Selector

In radio mode, repeatedly press BAND button on the remote control to select a band in the following order:



*\*Pressing BAND on the touchable screen or on the panel also performs the same operation.*

### 2. Manual/Automatic Tuning

- (1). Automatic Tuning: Press **◀▶** button on the remote control to search for a station in the direction of lower frequency or higher frequency.
  - (2). Manual Tuning: Press and hold **◀** or **▶** button repeatedly to move downward or upward one step respectively until the desired station frequency is displayed.
- \*Press (press and hold) **◀▶** button on panel also performs the operation*

### 3. Recalling a preset station

A total of 30 preset stations (18-FM, 12-MW) are available in memory.

Press **◀▶** button on the remote control to recall a preset station.

The display shows the preset number and frequency of the stored station, touch one of these to select a corresponding station to listening

*\*Press any one of the station preset button on the remote control also selects preset station.*

### 4. Automatic/Manual Store

Auto store is a function for storing up to 6 stations.

- (1) select the desired band
- (2) hold down AMS button, the stations with good reception are stored automatically.

Manual store: turn in a station you wish to store in the preset memory, press and hold any one the preset buttons (1-6) that you want to store on.

*\*If you store a station in a preset memory which already has a station the current station will be cleared and replaced with the new station.*

### 5. DX/LOC Selector

In radio mode, press LOC button on the remote control to select strong or weak station reception.

- (1). It is set to LOC mode when LOC button is first pressed. "Loc:ON" appears on the screen and only strong signal station will be tuned.

(2).It is switched to DX mode when Loc: OFF is pressed again. Both strong and weak stations can be received.

**Note:**

\* The initial mode is DX mode.

#### **6.MO/ST Selector**

In FM of radio mode, you can press ST button on the remote control to select **Mono** mode or **Stereo** mode.

#### **RDS (RADIO DATA SYSTEM) OPERATION**

The RDS allows you to receive a variety of information such as traffic information, station names, and to automatically retune to a stronger transmitter that is broadcasting the same programme.

##### **Tips**

The RDS digital data includes the followings:

PI Programme Identification  
PS Programme Service Name  
AF List of Alternative Frequencies  
TP Traffic Programme  
TA Traffic Announcement  
PTY Programme Type  
EON Enhanced Other Networks

##### **Turn on/off the AF function**

\* Press AF button to switch on/off AF function  
\*the tuner will search for a station with RDS information  
\* The tuner will retune frequencies whenever the reception signals getting worse.

##### **Receiving Traffic information**


1.Press the TA button to switch on TA mode.  
2.The unit search for traffic information station automatically.when a traffic information station is tuned in,the TP mark display on touchable screen.If you do not want to listen to the traffic information being received,press TA button to skip that traffic information message.the TA function will remain in the ON position.and the unit will be back to previous mode.  
3.Press it again to switch off TA mode.

\* Traffic information is heard only when it is being broadcast.

*In other mode,Traffic announcement can interrupt the source sound output when broadcast.  
After broadcasted ,the unit will automatically return to the original source play before the traffic information broadcast began.*

### **PTY(Programme Type) Tuning**

The PTY function allows you to search for stations with a particular Program Type. Touching Page1 button on the radio display screen to switch to the RDS screen



1. Press PTY button on touchable screen or on the remote control to select a programme type. After selecting the programme type for 3 seconds, the unit will search for a station in the selected programme type.

\*If the PTY station is found, the tuner will be stop searching.

\*If the PTY station is not found, "No Pty" will be display on the screen.

***An emergency broadcasting(ALARM) will broadcast automatically and produce the beep sound when it is received. The sound output through other source will be muted.***

## BLUETOOTH OPERATION

### HANDS-FREE PHONE

The unit is compatible with Bluetooth international standard wireless communication technology. You can place a hands-free call by using a Bluetooth compatible with the mobile phone.

\*When you place a call, speak loudly and clearly.

\*Shut the windows before calling.

\*It is normal that some unnatural voice may be heard during your calling which may be caused by the conditions of the signals or the one who use the mobile phone.

\*Due to some special mobile phone, you may not be able to use a hands-free phone.

\*The Bluetooth setting is required for a mobile phone. Read the Owner's Manual of the mobile phone.

\*After paired, the unit can connect with the mobile phone automatically. (in valid range)

\* If the mobile phone and the device are disconnected accidentally, the screen will display Disconnect, just press LINK button on the screen to reconnect (refer to Bluetooth setup).

### Dialling a call

1. Input the number required by pressing number button on the remote control or on the screen then press  button on the screen to dial up.

The telephone number you dialed is appeared on the screen



2. Placing a call by history:

Press  button to switch to PHONE BOOK screen. You can place a call by selecting a person from a list of received calls, dialed calls or missed calls.

*A maximum of 16 numbers can be stored in each call history. a maximum of 4 numbers be display in each page, and touch  button to turn to next page.*



### Receiving a Call

When a call is received, a received call sound rings, and the coming call is announced in the display. Press  button on the screen to starts the call.

### Hanging up a Call

Press  button on the screen to finishes the call.

\*Press  /  button on the remote control also perform dial(receiving) a call or hang up a call function

\*The incoming call will interrupt the sound output through other source, and switch to the hands-free phone screen automatically when it is received.

After the call is over, the unit will be back to previous mode.

\* The hands-free phone sounds output through the built-in speakers. When calling, press Audio Transfer button on the screen to switch the mode to receive a call by using mobile phone, and press it again to return to hands-free mode.

**BLUETOOTH AUDIO FUNCTION**

Audio information of a bluetooth compatible mobile phone, portable player, etc., is by wireless controllable/playable from the unit.



Refer to "CONNECT" to connect bluetooth audio devices.

Refer to bluetooth setup(PAGE6) for operation

\*video playback is not supported.



## TV OPERATIONS

### Selecting mode

Press SRC button on the remote control, on the panel or source selection touchable screen to select TV mode.



### Searching a channel

Automatic tuning:

Press **◀▶** buttons on the panel, or **◀▶** buttons on the remote control or SEEK-/SEEK+ buttons on the touchable screen to start auto searching the channel downward or upward.

Manual tuning:

Press and hold repeatedly **◀▶** buttons on the panel, **◀▶** buttons on the remote control or SEEK+/SEEK- buttons on the touchable screen to start manual searching the channel downward or upward.

### To Store a station automatically

Press and hold AMS button on the remote control or press AMS on the touchable screen. The unit will search for channels and store them under preset numbers in order of signal strength.

### Selecting channel

1. Press **◀▶** on the remote control to select previous or next stored channel.
2. You can Press(1-9) number button directly on the remote control to select preset channel. To select more than 10 channel number, firstly press GOTO button, then press the corresponding number buttons.
3. Press the needed channel number on the touchable screen. To select a page containing the needed channel number, press CH-/CH+ buttons on the screen.

### Selecting TV system

Press repeatedly PAL-I button on the touchable screen to change the TV system for different country.

### Note:

**When the TV channel picture is being broadcasted, touch the screen to return to the TV mode menu. The TV mode menu will be concealed when any operation is not performed within 5seconds.**

## DVD/VCD/CD OPERATIONS


### Loading a disc

1. Press **▲** button to open the front panel
  2. Insert a disc into the Disc slot, the unit switch to the DVD mode automatically
- \* You can eject a disc by pressing **▲** button on the unit

### **Quick track selection fast forward/fast reward playback**

During playback mode, press **◀◀/▶▶** button to select next/previous chapter or track.  
\*Press **◀◀/▶▶** button on the unit also perform the same operation.

Press the **◀◀ / ▶▶** button on the remote control to perform fast reward or fast forward.  
Repeatedly press the button, the options switch as follows order:



\*Press the **◀◀/▶▶** button on the unit for long time will perform the same function.

### **Stop the playback**

Press **■** button to stop playing, then press **ENTER** button to play the current chapter or track, press **■** button twice to stop playing completely, then press **ENTER** button to play the beginning of disc.

### **Pause the Playback**

Press **▶▶** button to pause the playback, press it again to return to normal playback.  
\*Pressing **▶▶** button on the front panel also perform the same operation.


### **Playing Tracks in Random Order**

During DVD/VCD/CD playback, press **RDM** button, “RANDOM” will appear on the display, the unit plays any track at random and the number selection is de-available.  
Press it again to return to normal playing.

### **Repeat Playing**

During DVD playback, the replay option change in following order:







#### **Increase or decrease the size of the picture**


During DVD/VCD playback, press ZOOM button to increase or decrease the picture size. There are 6 sizes, and press the button repeatedly to change the size in following order

#### **Selecting the channel mode(VCD mode)**

#### **Programmed playback**

In DVD/VCD/CD mode, press the PROG button and the program menu will be displayed. Press the number buttons to select the track number. Use the direction buttons to move the cursor to START and press ENTER to start programmed playback. Move the cursor to EXIT and press ENTER to exit the programmed playback. Move the cursor to PREV and press ENTER to go to the last page; move the cursor to NEXT and press ENTER to go to the next page. During this process, press PROG to cancel the programmed playback.

*\* This function can only be operated by using the remote control.*

#### **Changing the subtitle language(Multi-subtitle)**

With DVDs featuring multi-subtitle recordings. You can press SUB-T to switch between subtitle languages during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

Subtitle 01 — Subtitles 2 — Subtitles OFF

#### **Notes:**

- \* This function only operates with DVDs featuring multi-subtitle recordings.
- \* This function is operated by using the remote control.

#### **Changing the audio language**

DVDs can provide audio playback with different language. With DVDs featuring multi-audio recordings, you can press AUDIO button to switch between language and audio systems during playback. Selection options switch as follows:

Audio 01 — Audio 02

- \* This function only operates with DVDs featuring multi-audio recordings.
- \* This function is operated by using the remote control.

### **Selecting different title (DVD mode)**

For DVD disc, you can press TITLE on the remote control to return the top menu of the disc, and you can select different chapter or title upward or downward by using **▼** or **▲**.

*\*Touching the screen also perform the same function(refer to page 7 “Multi-player operation” for detail).*

### **Selecting root menu(DVD mode)**

For DVD disc, you can press MENU to select different root menus, and then press **[▲][▼][◀][▶][ENTER]** buttons to enter the sub-menus. With pressing **[▲][▼][◀][▶]** buttons, and the number buttons, and then ENTER button to select and enter what you desired.

### **Setup menu**

In DVD/VCD/CDmode, press SETUP, the screen will display system setting picture, the user can select some relative constant parameters. The user also can set it as needed by moving the cursor and using **[▲][▼][◀][▶]** buttons, and then press ENTER to execute the selecting or entering item.

*\*This function is operated by using the remote control.*

Notes:

- \* The selections are the preferred options that will be chosen if they are available on a disc. If the disc that is inserted does not have the preferred option then the discs own preference will be used.
- \* Regarding SETUP MENU, please refer to the following pages for more details.
- \* Some functions varies depending on the types of models or formats of the disc.

### **Auto switch to video**

When playing DVD in driving car, there is “Attention: Can't use function When driving” display on screen. Just braking car, the screen can switch to video automatically.

### **Auto switch when revering the car**

The unit can switch to the radar of revering the car automatically, when revering the car.

## SYSTEM SETUP






### 3.4 PARENTAL







## MP3 OPERATION

### Playing a disc, an SD/MMC card or a USB device containing MP3 files

Connect a USB device or insert a disc into the disc slot or SD/MMC card into the card slot. The unit will automatically switch on when a disc, card or USB device is inserted. The screen will display as follow:



Touch the / button on the screen to turn pages.

\*Press / button on the remote control when stop playback also perform the same function

\*You can eject a disc by pressing button on the unit.

### Repeat playing

When playing MP3 files, press the RPT button repeatedly on the remote control to select repeat mode: REPEAT ONE, OFF. While in REPEAT ONE mode, it will play one track repeatedly. The defaulted mode is REPEAT ALL mode, the unit will play all tracks repeatedly.

### Track selection

#### - Skip track backward/forward

When playing MP3 files, press / button on the remote control or press NEXT/PREV button on the touchable screen to go to the previous or next track.

#### - Selecting track by using number button

Selecting any track directly by using Number button(0-9).

To select more than 9 track number, press the corresponding number buttons continuously.

For example, if you want to play the 23th track, just press button 2 and then press button 3 and the corresponding track will be played.

## IPOD OPERATION

### 1. Playing an IPOD device containing audio and video files

During MP3 playback, press the **◀◀** or **▶▶** button on the RC or touch on NEXT/PREV button on the screen to select the next/previous track. Touch on the cursors on the screen to turn pages in the folder with more than 6 tracks.

#### Quick track selection

When playing MP3 files, touch on the track directly to go to the playing.

#### Repeat playing

When playing MP3 files, press the RPT button repeatedly on the remote control to select repeat mode: REPEAT ONE, ALL. While in REPEAT ONE mode, it will play one track repeatedly. The defaulted mode is REPEAT ALL mode, the unit will play all tracks repeatedly.

#### The number buttons

Selecting any track 10- directly by using Number button(0-9). For 10+ track, just press on GOTO button on the remote control then enter the relative digits. For example, if you want to play the 23th track, after pressing on GOTO button on the remote control and then press button 2 and then press button 3 and the corresponding track will be played.

Note: This function can be operated using the remote control.

#### PAUSE PLAYBACK

When playing MP3 files, press the **▶▶** button on the remote control or PAUSE button on the screen to pause playing then touch on the PLAY button to resume playing.

#### ISO FILE OPERATION

When playing the IPOD with folders, the unit will play the first track in the first folder automatically. Touch on the STOP button on the touch screen TWICE or the SETUP button on the remote control to enter folders interface.

Before finally installing the unit, connect the wiring temporarily, making sure it is all connected up properly, and the unit and the system work properly.


Use only the parts included with unit to ensure proper installation. The use of unauthorized parts can cause malfunctions.

Consult with your nearest dealer if installation requires the drilling of holes or other modifications of the vehicle.


Install the unit where it does not get in the driver's way and cannot injure the passenger if there is a sudden stop.

If installation angle exceeds 30° from horizontal, the unit might not give its optimum performance.




The cords must not cover up the area shown in the figure below. This is necessary to allow the enginery to radiate freely.




## Installation Method: DIN Front-Mount


