- 1) Show how this device meets the requirements of Section 80.203(b) as required by KDB 149672 section 2.

Our response to the above:

The operating channel selection of the SEA 157S is controlled by the front panel keypad of the radio and the rotary control. The station operator may select only authorized maritime channels, which have been pre-programmed and stored in the radio's read-only-memory by SEA COM Corporation or its authorized service personnel. The direct entry of operating frequency is not possible.

A table of Part 80 frequency allocations and usage may be found in the SEA 157S Operators Manual.

End users cannot not modify or re-program any pre-programmed channel of the SEA 157S. Re-programming requires the use of special software and access codes, which are available only to SEA COM Corporation and its authorized service and maintenance facilities. The special software and access codes are not available to third parties including end users, licensees, professional installers, repair shops, etc.
