

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Intended use

The products is intended for connection to a computer (USB port) and is used there to operate the operating system, for example.

• Scope of delivery

- 3D Wheel Mouse

• Setup

Connect the USB plug to a free USB port of your computer. The computer does not have to be switched off. Windows recognizes the new hardware and installs the required drivers. As the drivers are integrated in Windows, there is no driver data carrier within the scope of delivery.

Tips and notes

- The optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse does not work correctly on some surfaces, e.g. on glass or shiny, reflecting surfaces. Use a suitable mouse pad.
- Check the optical sensor occasionally as to whether particles of dust have been deposited on it and remove them with a soft brush.
- Don't use mouse at a changeless position for a long time.
