Dear Sir,

Elbit is requesting a waiver for the Micom Z for the above requirements for the following reasons:

1. The Micom Z transceivers are not for use on board ships of any kind, nor Coast stations. It is for Land based communications, and was granted certifications for FCC part 15 and part 90. As we have added the DSC capability, we now request the Part 80 waiver.
2. Part 80 approval for Micom Z is requested for the purpose of communications between land stations (using Micom Z transceivers) and Coast stations during a disaster, as stated in FCC waiver granted to Shipcom LLC for section 80.123. See application.
3. Although having a DSC capability, the Micom Z has a different appearance than a Marine DSC transceiver, avoiding the possibility of mistaking it to be a DSC Marine radio. This is mainly as the radio does not have a protected Emergency red button.
4. Following the above we request your approval of the Micom Z for Part 80 with the waiver for Part 80.123.
