Before using this product, carefully read all the precautions.

 The icon means warning; to prevent any possible injury, please read all the warnings before using the G-MATE™ product.

● Warning

- Prolonged use of MAG GUN may cause fatigue and exhaustion.
- MAG GUN is a professional equipment for video games, and cannot be used to imitate dangerous actions under non-game conditions.
- As MAG GUN applies induction operation, make sure to leave enough operating space around you and operate safely. MAG GUN is a professional equipment for FPS and TPS games, so it takes time to get used to and operate correctly.
- Skilled users can increase the sensitivity level of MAG GUN to reduce deviation between MAG GUN and target.
- Unauthorized opening of the exterior shell may cause electric shock. Maintenance and repair can only be performed by professional technicians.

● Provisions only applicable to certain regions

- According to the administrative regulations on low power radio waves radiated devices,

- Avoiding playing when you are tired or need sleep.
- Stop using it immediately if you begin to feel tired or if you experience discomfort or pain in your hands or arms while operating MAG GUN. If the condition persists, consult a doctor.

- If you experience any of the following health problems, discontinue use of MAG GUN immediately. If symptoms persist, consult with your physician.

Exterior Surfaces (plastics cover of MAG GUN and accessories)

Follow the instructions below to help prevent the exterior from deteriorating or becoming discolored.

- Wipe with a soft cloth.
- Do not apply insecticides or other volatile substances.
- Do not place rubber or vinyl materials on the product exterior for an extended period of time.
- Do not use solvent or other chemicals. Do not wipe with chemically-treated cleaning cloth.

Connectors

Do not use when the connectors of MAG GUN or its accessories are not clean. If used when dirty, the flow of electrical current may be obstructed. Remove the dirt with a clean soft cloth.

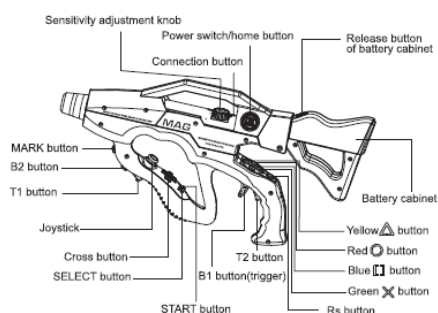

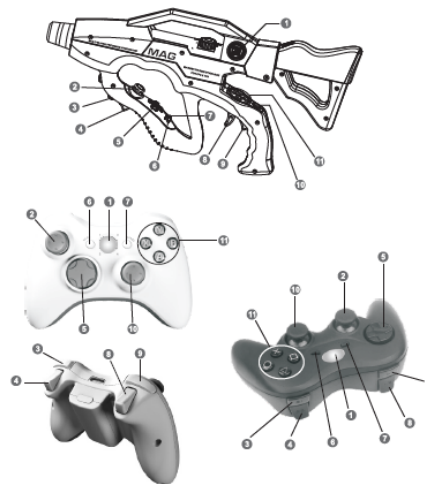
● Suggested connection methods of PC and TV

The connecting method should be chosen based on the functions of video card of PC. Any problem caused by video card functions is not subject to this manual. Please refer to PC or TV instruction manuals.

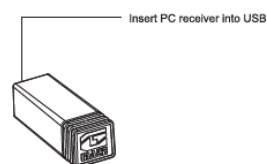
● Buttons distribution contrast

● Connect MAG GUN to PC



△ Notice

If the adapter cannot be identified by PC, it is suggested to use rear USB ports. Please do not use USB extension line or USB. Check the connection between MAG GUN and PC receiver. If there is still no response after connected, insert the receiver into PC USB interface, and press the connection button until the LED light is on, then release the connection button to finish the pairing.

△ Note

Connect after turning power off.


● Initial setting

- For the first-time use in a new environment, firstly, remove the battery cabinet and aim the gunpoint to the screen, press and hold MARK button, install the battery cabinet, swing the gunpoint to the other side until the power indicator is on. Then restart MAG GUN.
- Pair MAG GUN and the PC receiver. Insert PC receiver into PC USB interface, press and hold the connection button until the LED light of PC receiver is on. Then release the connection button and the pairing is completed. (The pairing has been established before delivery, so this step is only necessary if you changed receiver or some related items).

● Install and remove battery cabinet

- Please following the instructions below.
- To place batteries into AA battery cabinet of MAG GUN:
- Remove the battery cabinet
Press the release button on the top of the battery cabinet, hold the cabinet and slide backward to remove the cabinet.
 - Install batteries
Follow the battery installation diagram to install the batteries into the cabinet.
 - Install the battery cabinet
Place the bottom groove of the battery cabinet onto the guide rail on MAG GUN, slide forward, and the battery cabinet is locked with a cracking sound.
- To take out batteries from AA battery cabinet of MAG GUN:
- Press the release button on the top of the battery cabinet, hold the battery cabinet and slide backward to remove the cabinet.
 - Take out AA(LR6) batteries from the battery cabinet.

⚠ Notice
To avoid your fingers being caught, hold or press on flat surface of the battery cabinet.



Important

4 AA (LR6) batteries diagram

- As for the information of correctly disposing of batteries, please refer to safety of disposable batteries in MAG GUN Instructions Manual.
- Use AA (LR6) batteries; please confirm negative and positive poles of batteries before using. Do not charge batteries, burn them or use them by mixing with old ones or different types. Do not resolve batteries to avoid liquid leakage and breakage of batteries. If MAG GUN will not be used for a long time, batteries shall be taken out from it.

⚠ Notice
Safety of disposable batteries
Improper use of batteries may result in leakage, overheat or explosion. The use of different types of battery may cause fire. The battery leakage is corrosive and/or poisonous and may cause burn if it comes into contact with skin or eyes, and it may lead to injury if it is swallowed. To reduce the risk of injuries:

- Keep batteries out of reach of children.
- Do not heat, open, drill, disassemble or throw a battery into fire.
- Only use AA(LR6) alkaline batteries.
- Please do not mix new batteries with used ones.

- Remove the batteries when they run down. If the battery pack is not installed in MAG GUN, do not leave batteries in AA battery cabinet. If battery leaks, remove them immediately and avoid its electrolyte comes into contact with skin or clothes.
- If contacts, wash the contact area with cleaning water. Before install new batteries, clean the cabinet with wet tissue or follow the methods recommended by battery manufacturers.
- Please dispose batteries according to local and national waste disposal regulations.

● Turning power on and off

Before turning on power, you need adjust the sensitivity knob. Level 1-4 is suggested for beginners, level 5-8 for intermediate users and level 9-12 for advanced users(Recommend to use level 5) see page 25.
Hold MAG GUN and stand in front of the screen, see page 23.
Press and hold the switch button for 3 seconds. The power indicator lights up indicates the device is turned on.

Solid blue	The power is on
Flashing blue	Replace low batteries
Indicator light off	The power is off (standby mode)

Press the power button until the indicator light off.

Tips

- 1.Please check the connection status of the receiver before use, refer to page 16 for detailed information.
- 2.Remove the batteries when MAG GUN will not be used for a long time, so as to avoid slowly draining, leakage or breakage of batteries.

⚠ Notice

Be sure not to wrongly connect the battery's positive and negative terminals. Do not discard batteries and do not leave batteries near high temperature locations to avoid leakage and damage.

● Matching game functions with the buttons

Before playing a game, you need access game settings to establish the correspondence between the game functions and MAG GUN buttons. MAG GUN's factory default settings are settled according to some of the games it supports. Please establish correspondence between games functions and buttons according to your use habit. For the corresponding letters of different buttons, please refer to the diagram on page 24 .

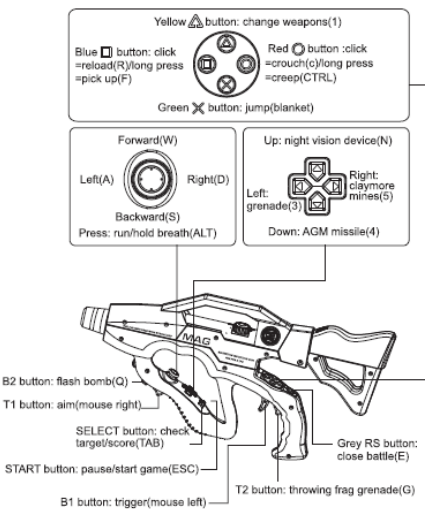


● Playing games

Supported games: MAG GUN supports most FPS games on PC (First Person Shooting Game), such as Call of Duty, Battlefield, Medal of Honor and Far Cry, etc. As well as TPS games(Third Person Shooting Game),such as Gears of War and Halo, etc.

Tips

- Not guaranteed to support all FPS and TPS games.

Take a FPS game for example, it is the reciprocal diagram of buttons of MAG GUN and the functions of games(graphics)

Note: The bracketed letters or numbers are equivalent to keys on the keyboard.

● Choose correct posture

As shown in the diagram, choose the best way to hold MAG GUN. (Recommend to play games in standing posture. For right-handed users, it is suggested to put the left hand in the front with left thumb on the joystick, and the right hand holds the grip, thus the gun can be held steadily by both hand. On the contrary, for left-handed users, it is suggested to put the right hand in the front with right thumb on the joystick, and the left hand holds the grip. This recommended posture is only for reference, and the actual operation depends on personal habit).



Posture diagram

● Sensitivity adjustment

Adjust the sensitivity knob to select a level that suitable for you. Level 1-3 is suggested for beginners, level 4-6 for intermediate users and level 7-8 for advanced users (Recommend to use level 5).

● Age limits

Users are required to be mentally mature.

Users are required to reach the age of 14.

The product is only for playing video games, please do not imitate game actions in real life.

Please be aware of the exposure of restricted content to Children when playing with MAG GUN. Age limits of audio-visual contents vary in different games and different games platforms, please choose carefully.

● Mark gunpoint position

Aim at the screen center, press MARK button to mark the position of gunpoint and then release Mark button.

● Start to play

Start to enjoy the fun of the games. If you find it hard to control the pictures when playing, please adjust sensitivity knob to a suitable level.

Press START button to pause or restore games.

If the gunpoint deviates too much from the screen in game, press and hold MARK button to target the gunpoint to the screen center, release the button, and the gunpoint position has been re-marked.

Tips

When you are using MAG GUN, electromagnetic interference in the game environment may cause abnormality. Please reset according to initial setting in such situations. See page 17.

● Reset

You may need to reset as below when the operation environment changes..

- Re-calibrate MAG GUN when location changes or irregular movement of pictures on screen. First, remove the battery cabinet, press MARK button and reinstall the cabinet. Then swing the gun towards the other side. Until the power indicator lights up. Then restart MAG GUN.
- Re-calibrate if cursor moves without movement of MAG GUN. Remove the battery cabinet and lay MAG GUN flat. Then press T2 button and reinstall the battery cabinet. After the power indicator light off, release your hand restart MAG GUN.
- Reset if more than one MAG GUN will be used within the same space. Choose one MAG GUN and insert the PC receiver into PC USB interface, press and hold the connection button until the LED light of PC receiver is on. Then release the button and the pairing is completed. When pairing the second MAG GUN, remove the previous PC receiver and replaced by a new one before pairing operation.

● Before requesting service

Go through this section if you experience difficulty in operating MAG GUN. Should any problem persists, please contact MAG GUN Customer Service Center by the contact information printed on the package carton.

● Power

- MAG GUN cannot turn on:
- Check if the batteries are correctly installed.
 - Check if positive and negative terminals are correctly connected.
 - Check if the battery capacity is sufficient. When the power indicator of MAG GUN flashes, it indicates low battery. Please replace batteries as soon as possible. Refer to Page 18 for detailed instructions.

● Connection

- MAG GUN cannot function correctly
- Please check the battery capacity of MAG GUN. When the power indicator of MAG GUN flashes, it indicates low battery. Please replace batteries as soon as possible. Refer to Page 18 for detailed instructions.
 - Please check operation distance. MAG GUN is a wireless operation device which can be used at a distance of over 5 meters from the PC receiver. While actual distance may vary depending on different operating environment. Do not operate too far away from the receiver to avoid signal reception is affected.
 - If MAG GUN still cannot be connected after checked all the mentioned items, please pair MAG GUN and PC receiver. Press and hold the connection, after the LED light of PC receiver is on, release the connection button and then the pairing is completed.

● Other problems

- Different games require different PC configurations. Please refer to the relevant game instructions for details.
- The game response speed may be slow due to PC configuration. This is not a malfunction.

● Calibration

- Abnormal waves on the screen caused by MAG GUN
- Adjust the sensitivity knob according to your proficiency level. The larger number, the higher sensitivity, and the harder to control.
 - If you cannot play even after checking the above, trying resetting and initializing. See page 17 for details.

● Button

- If wrong movements occur during the process of playing, please check whether there is any button getting stuck.
