

Bluetooth module BT-402 USER GUIDE

1. GENERAL

BT-402 is a Bluetooth communication module complying with Bluetooth Version 3.0.

Frequency Range: 2402-2480 MHz

Antenna type: PCB

Power Class: Class 2

Bluetooth chip: BlueCore4

Memory: 48KB RAM; 8Mbit Flash

Power supply: 3.3V \pm 5%

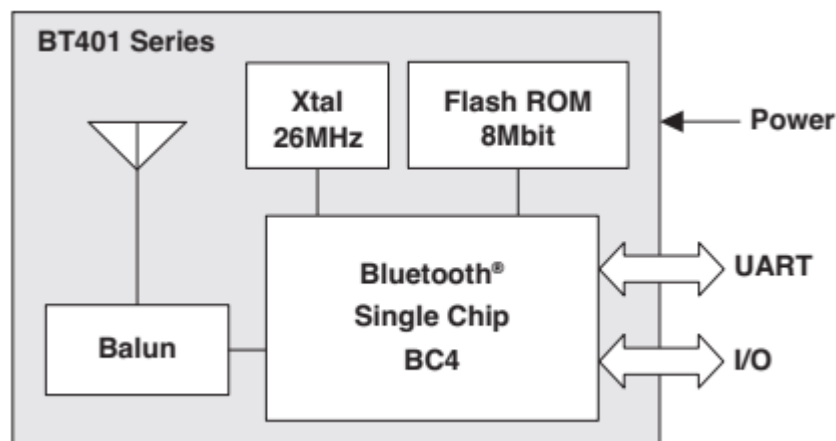


Fig. Block Diagram

2. REGULATORY

FCC NOTICE
