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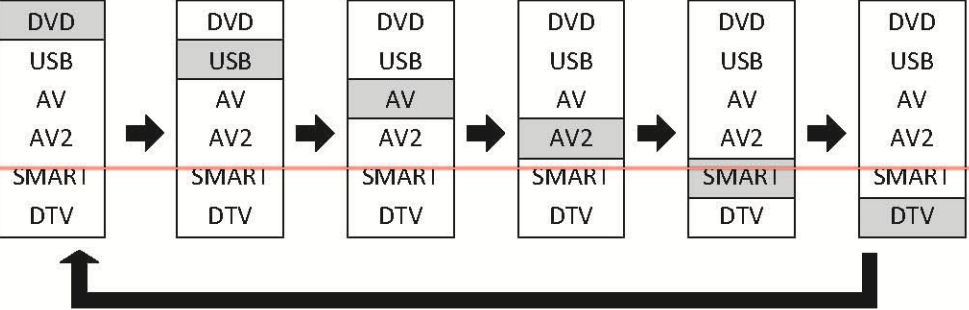

How to change VIDEO Sources

This unit has 6 different Modes. DVD, USB, AV, AV2, SMART, DTV



- DVD
 - Press OPEN button on the unit to load DVD or CD disc
 - Completely close the LCD flip until you hear the sound "Click"
 - DVD or CD disc will be playing automatically.
- USB
 - Put USB Memory on the slot locted on right bottom side (inside of folding flip)
 - Press V.SEL button on the unit or Remote to move cursor to USB on the screen
 - Select target file using <</>> buttons in the unit or <</>> button on the remote
 - Press"PLAY" button on the unit or remote to play & pause the file
 - Press"EXIT" button on the unit or remote to move to previous folder
- AV
 - AV input locate on the left bottom side of unit(Inside of folding flip)
 - You can simply connect Portable or Handheld devices to this front AV input
- AV2
 - AV2 input locate on the DIN to RCA cable (together with POWER and AV output)
 - This input designed for slave external devices such as TV tuner or Game console
- SMART
 - Please connect SMART LINK cable from external unit to Headrest's SMART input port.
 - Please change Video mode to SMART
 - Operate External device (especially video). Same picture as external device will be shown on the Headrest screen
- DTV
 - This input designed for Digital TV.
 - Only able to watching Digital TV Connect with TV-300 tuner box (sold seperately).
 - Defail Position method is explained on TV-300 Manual.

- * Smart phone Interface
- Basically, operation for SMART LINK function of Smart phone is same as above
 - To operate your Smartphone, please connect the specific cable shown below
 - Please make sure USB needs to be connected on the port to activate SMART LINK function on the smart phone
