## Troubleshooting

Symptoms and Problems	Causes and Solutions
Power supply failure	Check the power connection is correct
Time setting error	If it is not connected to power adapter for long time, the current time settings will be cleared. Always connect the power adapter
Preview is too slow	The preview speed may be slower when processing large images and more pictures
Fail to automatically play pictures	Ensure <Startup Mode> in <Settings> - <General> is set to <Image>
Unable to play image	Maybe incorrect image format and JPG image format
Fail to read the contents of memory card	Incorrect content format or bad memory card, ensure that it is correct
Unable to copy file	Memory card is full or file format is not supported or bad memory card, ensure enough space in the memory card and the file format is supported by the device
No sound output	Check the remote controller is set to silent mode and the sound volume is 0
Unable to connect to PC	Check the cable to connect PC is bad or poor contact between the interface and PC interface
Unavailable repeat play	Select Repeat Mode in <Settings> options
Jam when playing file	Check the memory card is damaged
Auto Shutdown	Close Auto-shutdown in <Settings> options
Remote failure	Check the battery power is inadequate. Remote controller shall be aimed to picture frame receiver
Images can not be displayed in full-screen or in proportion	Select Image Play Mode or select Full-screen Mode or Half-screen Mode in <Settings> options

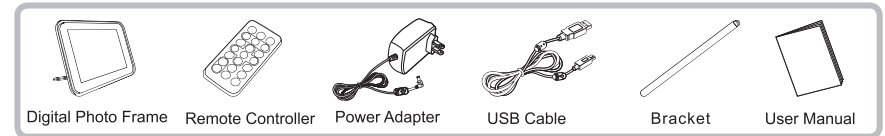

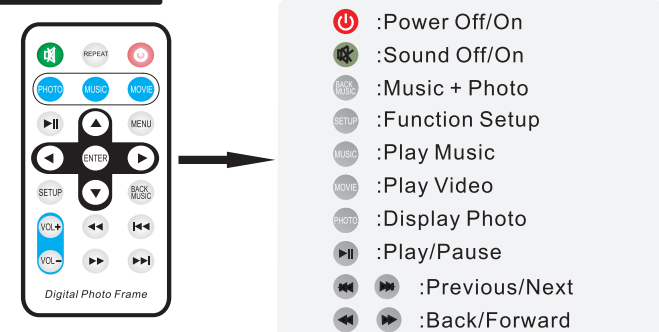

### Name and Function of Component Part

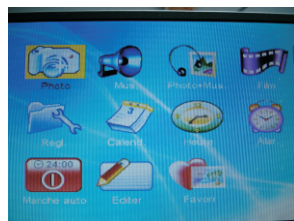


### Remote Controller

## Menu Settings



(Option)

User may move the pointer by using buttons in Remote Controller to operate each menu function.

photo	In Main Menu, select photo option and press Confirm button, the system will automatically browse photo files in storage card or memory card, and user may select corresponding photo preview by pressing   buttons in Remote Controller. If there is no image file the system will automatically return to the Main Menu.
Music	In Main Menu, select Music option and press confirm button, the system will automatically browse music files in storage card or memory card, and user may select corresponding music by pressing   buttons in Remote Controller. If there is no music file the system will automatically return to the Main Menu.
photo + Music	In Main Menu, select Image + Music option and press Confirm button, the system will automatically load the other files for slideshow. If there is no file system will automatically return to the main menu.
Movie	In Main Menu, select Movie option and press Confirm button, the system will automatically browse movie files in storage card or memory card, and user may select corresponding video by pressing   buttons in Remote Controller. If there is no video file the system will automatically return to the Main Menu.
Setting	In Main Menu, select Setting option and press Confirm button, the system will automatically enter into Menu Manager, and user may edit each option in Menu Manager by pressing :  Image Setting: 1.Interval Setting for Image Play 2.Effect Mode Switching for Image Play 3.Image Play Mode  [Half / Full Screen] 4.Image Auto Play Mode  [Normal / Sport Mode / Calendar Mode] 5.Image Browse Mode  [Thumbnail / File Management] Startup Auto-Play Settings: 1. Image  [Open / Close] 2. Music  [Open / Close] 3. Movie  [Open / Close] Display Settings: 1. Brightness  [ Normal / bright / soft] 2. Contrast 3. TFT Brightness 4. TFT Contrast 5. Calendar	In Main Menu, select Calendar option and press Confirm button, the system will enter into Calendar Setting. Then select Date Setting by pressing   and press Confirm to enter into Calendar Setting, for example, edit 2008/08/08, use   buttons to select Year, press  to move to Month for editing. Press  to select OK to confirm after the editing is OK and finally press  to select Exit and press Confirm to exit.

## Menu Settings

Clock	In Main Menu, select Clock option and press Confirm button, the system will enter into Clock Setting. Then use   buttons to select Time Setting and press confirm to enter into Time Setting. Use   buttons to select Clock and press  to move to Minute for editing, press  to select OK to confirm when editing is OK, then press  button to select Exit and press Confirm to exit calendar setting.
Alarm Clock	In Main Menu, select Alarm Clock and press Confirm button to enter into Using, press  to select On and press Confirm to Open Alarm Function Setting, use  button to select Time Setting and press Confirm to enter, then use   buttons to set alarm time, after is OK, press  to select OK and press Confirm, finally use  to select Exit and press Confirm to exit.
Auto On / Off	In Main Menu, select Auto On / Off option and press Confirm to enter, use   buttons to select On / Off to enable auto timer function On / Off. If user uses timer function, then use  button to select Time Setting to set On / Off time. After setting, use  to select Exit and press Confirm to exit.
Edit	In Main Menu, select Edit and press Confirm button, under this mode, user may copy files from memory card built-in memory, and also may delete files from built-in memory. Copy: This function can be used to copy files from a memory card into internal memory, after enter into the Manager, use   buttons to select corresponding files and press Confirm button. Then press  to select Edit and press Confirm, Copy/Delete will appear. Then use   to select Copy and press Confirm, and press  button to select Built-in Memory and press Confirm, repeat press  button to select Edit and press Confirm, Paste will appear, then press Confirm button to complete the operation. Delete: This function can be used to delete files from a memory card, after enter into the Manager, use   buttons to select corresponding files and press Confirm button, then press  to select Edit and press Confirm, Copy/Delete will appear. Then use   to select Delete and press Confirm, select Yes and press Confirm button, file delete operation will be completed
Favorites	This function is mainly playing images in built-in memory. In the Menu, select Favorites, press Confirm button the system will automatically play images in built-in memory
E-book	This function is mainly playing e-books in built-in memory. In the Menu, select E-book, press Confirm button the system will automatically preview e-books in built-in memory
