


No sound or picture.	Check that the mains lead has been connected to a wall socket. Check that you have pressed the POWER button. Check the picture contrast and brightness settings. Check the volume.
Normal picture but no sound.	Check the volume. Check whether the MUTE button has been pressed on the remote control.
No picture or black and white picture	Adjust the colour settings. Check that the broadcast system selected is correct.
Sound and picture interference.	Try to identify the electrical appliance that is affecting the set and move it further away. Plug your set into a different mains socket.
Blurred or snowy picture, distorted sound.	Check the direction, location and connections of your aerial. This interference occurs often due to the use of an indoor aerial.
Remote control malfunctions.	Check the batteries in the remote control. They may need replacing. Operate the remote control at a distance of no more than 8 meter. Clean the upper edge of the remote control (transmission window). Remove batteries and hold down one or more buttons for several minutes to drain the microprocessor inside the remote control to reset it. Reinstall batteries and try to operate the remote control again.
"No signal" message is displayed.	Check that the signal cable is firmly connected to the PC. Check that the PC is turned on.

Setting up Your PC Software (Based on Windows XP)

The Windows display-settings for a typical computer are shown below. But the actual screen on your PC will probably be different, depending upon your particular version of Windows and your particular video card. 




Preparation

Stand Installation


1 Carefully place the TV with its front side facing down on a cushioned flat surface.



2 Attach the TV stand to the TV as shown.



3 Tighten the supplied $\varnothing 4 \times 10$ screws to fix the TV stand securely in place.



The TV stand may not be securely fixed in place after repeated tightening and loosening the screws.


During assembling and disassembling the TV stand, please use your hand to support it. Failing to do so may cause the TV stand to fall and result in personal injury.

After installing the TV stand, please ensure that the screws are tightened firmly. Failure to do so may cause the TV set to tip over or become damage.


Detaching the TV Stand for Wall Mounting

Before mounting the TV on the wall, the TV stand must be removed.


1 Carefully place the TV with its front side facing down on a cushioned flat surface.




2 Unscrew and remove the 4 screws as shown.



3 Remove the TV stand with two hands.



4 Attach the cap as shown.



- Fasten the wall bracket to the TV using the supplied M5x15 screws.
- For wall bracket installation, refer to the wall bracket instruction guide.

Digital CC Style

1. Select "Setup--Closed Caption--Digital CC Style" press **►** to enter.

2. Press **▲▼** button to select the desired item to enter.

3. Press **◀▶** buttons on the remote control to adjust desired item.

4. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to return to upper menu.

Notes:

1. This function is activated in Digital TV receiving.
2. If set to Custom, the blocked Digital CC style will released, using the Navigator **◀▶▲▼** and ENTER buttons to set the style of the words of closed caption as desire.



Clock

1. Select "Setup--Clock" press **►** to enter.

2. Press **▲▼** button to select the desired item to enter.

3. Press **◀▶** buttons on the remote control to adjust desired item.

4. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to return to upper menu.

If Auto Clock is selected, press the Navigator **◀▶** button to turn it On or Off. (When turn on, the TV will display the time from Digital TV station directly. Function is depend on the signal emit from TV station).



Others Menu

Others

1. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to enter the OSD menu. Then press **▲▼** buttons to select the "Others", press **►** or ENTER button to enter.

2. Press **▲▼** button to select the desired item to enter.

3. Press ENTER buttons on the remote control to adjust desired item.

4. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to return to upper menu.



No Signal Power Off: If turn On, the TV will power off automatically if no more TV signals received over than 10 minutes. This function is design to save the energy when you are sleeping during watching TV in midnight.

No Operation Power Off: If turn On, the TV will power off automatically if no any buttons was pressed within 3 hours. This function is design to save the energy when you are sleeping during watching TV.

All Reset: Press the ENTER button to reset all setting to default settings.

Parental Control


1. If Change Password is selected, press ENTER button to enter. The CHANGE PASSWORD menu will appear and Old PIN will be highlighted. Enter the preset 4 digit password (or the super password 0000) by pressing the numeric buttons. New PIN will be highlighted automatically. Enter the new 4 digit password. Confirm will be highlighted, re-enter the new password then press the MENU button to save the new password and exit.

2. If Front Panel Lock is selected, press the ENTER button to turn this function On or Off.

Note: When locked, all the control buttons on the top of TV (except Power On/Off button) will be locked.





Antenna and Power Connections




① Connect the antenna cable into the antenna input terminal at the rear panel and wall antenna socket.

Securing the TV Set



Secure the TV set as shown above using screws that are available in the market.

- If you do not take the above safety measures, the TV set could fail and result in personal injury or physical damage.

To set and activate it by:

*Enter to the parental control menu as previously procedures, the PARENTAL CONTROL menu will appear on the screen and Lock Parental Control will be highlighted.

*Enter the default password 0000 by presses the numeric buttons. Then the cursor will remove and highlighted the V-CHIP automatically.

*Press the ENTER button to enter, the V-CHIP menu will appear on the screen and Lock System will be highlighted. Press the Navigator **◀▶▲▼** button to turn the V-Chip On or Off.

*If the US V-Chip or Canada V-Chip is selected. Press the ENTER button to enter them using the Navigator **◀▶▲▼** buttons to set the block level as the on screen instructions as desire. Press the MENU button to save the settings and exit.




Notes:

1. If new Rating level is available. The blocked "Downloadable Rating" in the V-CHIP menu will be activated automatically. Enter to it then download the new rating system as the on screen instructions. To delete the downloaded new rating system, enter to the "Clear Downloadable Data" then delete the new system as the on screen instructions.
2. If Change Password is selected, using the Navigator **◀▶▲▼**, ENTER and numeric buttons to set a new password as desire. (NOTE: If the preset password was forgotten, you can use the super password 0000 to reset a new password.)
3. If Front Panel Lock was selected, press the ENTER button to turn it On (All the button on the top of TV except Power On/Off button will be locked) or Off.

Channel Setting


Select "Channel--Channel Setting" press ▶ to enter.





AUDIO	Press this button to display and select different TV Audio systems or Language.
F-LIST	Press to display the Favorite List on the screen.
C-LIST	Press to display the Channel List on the screen.
EPG	Open/close Electronic program guide.
CC	Press this button to turn on caption vision, the caption vision will turn off after press again.


Install The Remote Control Batteries



1. Open the battery cover.
2. Insert batteries (two size-AA batteries). Place batteries with their terminals corresponding to the (+) and (-) indications.
3. Replace the cover and slide in reverse until the lock snap. If the remote control is not used for an extended period of time, remove the batteries from the remote control.

Range of Remote Control

- Ensure the remote control is pointed towards the remote control window on the display unit.
- No obstacles should be placed between the remote control and the remote control window.
- The effective receiving range for the signal is within 5-8 meters from the front of the remote control window, and 30° to the left or right side and 20° above or below the control window.



Placing In Standby Mode

Your TV can be placed in Standby mode in order to reduce the power consumption. The standby mode can be useful when you wish to interrupt viewing temporarily (during a meal, for example).

1. Press the Power button.
Remark: TV will turn off and the LED turns red.
2. To switch back on, simply press power button.

Remark: Do not leave your TV in Standby mode for long periods of time. (when you are away on holiday, for example). It is the best to unplug the set from the mains and aerial.

Screen Settings

Select "Picture--Screen Settings" press **►** to enter.

Screen Size: Press **◀ ▶** buttons to select.
Auto Wide: Press **ENTER** buttons to turn on or turn off.
Horizontal Position: Adjust the Horizontal Position of the Screen.
Vertical Position: Adjust the Vertical Position of the Screen.




PC Settings

Select "Picture--PC Settings" press **►** to enter.

Auto Adjust: Press **◀ ▶** buttons. TV system adjust by itself, it can adjust H Position, V Position, Phase and so on that can make the image in center and display best.
Clock: Adjust the clock of the PC Screen display.
Phase: When necessary, adjust the pixel phase of the picture to avoid picture interference.

NOTE: PC Settings is available only under the VGA source mode.



Color Temperature

You can select your favorite Color Temperature.

Select "Picture--Color Temperature" press **►** to enter.

1. Press **◀ ▶** button to select the "Color Temperature".
2. Press the **"MENU"** button on the remote control to return to upper menu.

Color Temperature


Warm

Normal: Adjust the colour value.
Warm: Adjust the white colour to a little bit red.
Cold: Adjust the white colour to a little bit blue.

Remark: The changes you made will be stored automatically.

Setting Menus

1. Press the **MENU** button to enter to the setting menu (press again to exit).
2. Press the **Navigator** **▲▼** button to select and highlight the function within the menu you want to adjust. Press the **ENTER** button to go to the sub-menu or to confirm the selection. Press the **Navigator** **◀▶** button to adjust.
3. During setting, press the **EXIT** button to return to previous menu.



Picture

1. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to enter the OSD menu. Then press **▲▼** buttons to select the "PICTURE", press **▶** or **ENTER** button to enter.
2. Press **▲▼** button to select the desired item to enter.
3. Press **◀▶** buttons on the remote control to adjust desired item.
4. Press the "MENU" button on the remote control to return to upper menu.



Picture Settings

Select "Picture--Picture Settings" press **▶** to enter.

Picture Mode: Press **◀▶** buttons to select the following option are available: "Standard, Movie, User, Dynamic."


Brightness: Adjust the color saturation.

Power On/ Off And Standby

Turning on the TV

1. Plug the TV's power adapter cord into a wall outlet (after this step, the TV will turn on and enter standby mode automatically). The power button indicator will turn red.
2. Press the **(Power)** button on the TV, or press the **(Power)** button on the remote control. The TV will turn on.

Turning off the TV

Press the **(Power)** button on the TV again, or press the **(Power)** button on your remote control again, and the TV will turn to standby mode. (The power button indicator will turn red.)

Switching Input

1. Turn on all connected equipment or computers.
2. Press the **(SOURCE)** button on your TV or on your remote control to display the Source Menu.
3. Press the **(▲▼)** button to select modes and press **(◀▶)** or **Enter** to confirm.

Changing Programs

Using the Program selection buttons on the Remote Control to Change Programs

1. To select a program, press the corresponding program selection button on the remote control. For example, to select program 8, press the "8" program selection button on the remote control.
2. To select a program number over 99, press the corresponding program selection button on the remote control. For example, to select program 99, and then press the "9", "9" program selection buttons on the remote control.

Using the P \wedge / P \vee buttons to sequentially change programs

Press **(P \wedge)** or **(P \vee)** on your remote control or on the TV to sequentially select the TV programs available in your area.


Using the SWAP button to return the previous program

To return to the previous viewed program, press the **(**  **)** button on your remote control.


Connections

You can connect VCR, DVD player, set-top box, computer, game console or other video equipment to the TV. To view external source images, press "SOURCE" to select the input source.


Connecting an AV Equipment with HDMI Connector




Connecting an AV Equipment with Composite Connector




Connecting an AV Equipment with Component (YPbPr/YCbCr) Connector

Connecting audio amplifier (for all signal source)





Main Menu

AUTO SEARCHING


The method to search and automatically store the available TV (including the traditional Analog NTSC and Digital ATSC TV stations) stations located in your area:

- Press the SOURCE button on the top of TV repeatedly to set the input source to TV. (Or, press the SOURCE button on the remote control, the Source menu will appear on the screen. Press the Navigator **▲▼** button to select and highlight TV then press ENTER button to enter to TV mode.)
- Press the MENU button on the TV or remote control. The MAIN MENU will appear on the screen.



Channel

- Press the Navigator **▲▼** button to select and highlight CHANNEL then press the ENTER button to enter. The CHANNEL menu will appear on the screen.
- Press the Navigator **▲▼** button to select and highlight the Signal Type then press the Navigator **◀▶** button to set the input signal type to Air or Cable as the RF connection of the TV.



Auto Channel Search

Notes:

- Set to Air if you are connecting the TV to the antenna to receive the TV broadcasting over the air.
- Set to Cable if you are connecting the TV to a Cable TV Converter.

*Press the Navigator **▲▼** button to select and highlight Auto Channel Search then press the ENTER button to Execute. The TV will start searching all the available Analogue and Digital TV stations and store them in the Channel List.

*When finished searching, press the MENU button to exit. Press the **▲▼** button to select the stored TV program as desire.
