These headphones must be used with compatible devices that support wireless connection technology.


### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:



## HOW TO CHARGE

Step 1: Connect the small end of the USB cable to the USB-C charging port on the right earcup.



Step 2: Connect the other end to a USB-A power source such as a computer or wall charger, Red LED is solid on when charging, and it will turn blue after fully charged.




### NOTES:

- The headphones will be power off and begin to charge when connected to an external power source. To continue using the headphones, please remove it from the power source and power them on again.
- The headphones won't charge while they're powered on.
- The headphones don't support USB audio. To play audio from a source device connected, such as computer, please use Bluetooth connection.

## POWER ON/OFF

**POWER ON:** Press and release the Power on/off button. After a few seconds, you hear a voice prompt announces "Power on". Then headphones go to searching mode and LED flash in red and blue. Once headphones connected to device, you hear a voice prompt announces "Bluetooth connected", and LED goes off.

**POWER OFF:** Press and hold the button until you hear a voice prompt announces "Power off".  
Auto-off :The headphones conserve the battery and go to auto-off if the headphone is not connected to the device over 5 minutes. To power on the headphones, press and release the Power button.



## HOW TO CONNECT

Connect to new device


- Step 1: Turn on the Bluetooth setting on your mobile device.  
Step 2: Power on the headphones. It will go to Bluetooth pairing mode with flashing red and blue LED.  
Step 3: Find and click "Infinitive ANC BT headphones BK" from your mobile device.  
Step 4: Once Bluetooth is connected, voice prompt announces "Bluetooth connected", LED goes off.



Reconnect to previous device

- Step 1: Make sure your mobile device's Bluetooth is turned on.  
Step 2: Power on the headphones. Headphones will connect to your mobile device automatically.

Volume up	Press the Volume+ button ⑤
Volume down	Press the Volume- button ③
Skip forward	Press and hold the Next song button ⑤
Skip backward	Press and hold the Previous song button ③
Answer Call	Press the Make phone call button ④
Hang up Call	Press and hold the End phone call button ④
Turn on ANC	Press the ANC on/off button ⑦, voice prompt announces ANC on, Green LED is solid.
Voice Assistant	Press twice on the Voice Assistant button ④
Game/Music mode	Press twice on the Game mode/Music mode button ⑦, voice prompt announces gaming mode, press twice more, voice prompt announces music mode

### TROUBLE SHOOTING

Connection failure or headphones disconnected from each other, manual reset may be required, follow the steps below:

1. Power on the headphones.
2. To reset, press Power on/off button ④ 5 times.
3. You'll hear a voice prompt announcing "Reset", and the headphones power on.
4. Clear pairing record between headphones and devices.
5. Please continue Step 2 to Step 4 of "Connect to new device".
