

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
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ZX700 Features

CD/MP3/DVD Disc Player

Compatible with standard size CD MP3 and DVD discs (4.75" or 12 cm). The ZX700 is designed to read standard CD, MP3, DVD, DVD+R, DVD-R Disc. Because of variations in 3rd party recording methods some discs may not play on this unit.

Built-In AM/FM Tuner

27 preset FM stations and 18 AM stations available to select

Built-In Weather Band Tuner

This unit can receive the latest weather forecast reports broadcast on 7 different frequencies - with strongest station automatically selected.

3 Audio and Video Output locations

This unit supplies quality high power audio and video outputs to three different rooms. Room A receives 5.1 full digital surround sound. Room B and C receive standard stereo audio.


Four Inputs (2 Audio Video and 2 Audio)

This unit has one AV-IN (INPUT1) and one AUDIO-IN (INPUT2) to allow users to enjoy Audio and Video entertainment from other AV sources such as Satellite Radio, iPod Video, VCR, Digital Camera, Video Game Player, etc. These sources must be connected through the two inputs on the back of the unit or through additional accessory wall plates.

Sound Equalization Control

Allows control of the Bass, Treble, Balance and EQ. It allows the modification of sound in each of the available 3 rooms.

Basic Keys

**POWER**

Turns the power on and off

**VOLUME**

Increase or decrease the volume in all rooms where sound is being played.

**MUTE**

Turn the sound off or on with this single button. Works on all Rooms where the sound is being played.

**SOUND**

Controls under this Menu include Volume, Base, Treble, Balance and EQ controls.

Volume: 39 different levels
 Bass: 14 different levels
 Treble: 14 different levels
 Balance: 14 different levels
 EQ: Pop, Class, Rock, Flat

**EJECT**

Ejects the disc from the ZX700.

**ABC Room Keys**

Turns sound on or off in corresponding rooms A, B or C.

**Left and Right Arrows**

Radio: Press these buttons to select next frequency higher or lower.
 DVD: MENU turn page.

**Left and Right Double Arrows**

Radio: Press these buttons for station SEEK.
 Disc: Move to previous track or next track on disc.

PLAY/PAUSE

Press to play disc or pause playback of disc.

STOP

Press to stop playback of disc.
 Press Play to continue the playback.

FAST FORWARD


Radio: Scan through all higher preset stations.
 Disc: Select different levels of fast forward.

FAST REVERSE

Radio: Scan through all lower preset stations.
 Disc: Select different levels of fast reverse.

DISPLAY

Shows all functions occurring within the ZX700

**DISC INSERT**

Unit holds a single disc. The disc inserts and ejects from this opening.

FUNCTION

Select between RADIO, DISC, AU2, AV1, AU2.

BAND

Allows you to select FM1, FM2, FM3, AM1, AM2 or Weather Band.

SETUP

Press for DVD setup menu.

0-9 NUMBERS

Radio: Press to select preset stations. For details on setting preset stations, please see page 4.

Disc: Selects different tracks on CD and different chapters on DVD.

**100+**

Radio: N/A.

Disc: Press the 100+ area on the "0" button to select tracks numbered higher than 100 on MP3s.

Radio Using The Main Unit



It is important to understand what is shown on the digital display:

1. Band Indicator: Indicates the radio band. AM1, 2 FM 1, 2, 3 or Weather Band
2. Frequency Indicator: Indicates the radio frequency.
3. Preset Number Indicator: Indicates the preset station is selected.

The radio is divided into five bands; FM1, FM2, FM3 and AM1, AM2. There are 9 positions available for each band to preset favorite stations.



FUNCTION

How to select the Radio Reception Mode

Push the BAND button and the unit switches to Radio immediately. Or, push the FUNCTION button until RADIO shows on the digital display.

How to preset the desired station to the selected pushbutton

To preset 89.3 MHz (frequency 89.3 MHz and FM3 band is used as an example only) at No.6 of FM3 band, the user needs to switch to the FM3 band first and push left or right tuning button to tune to 89.3 MHz. Then push and hold the No. 6 button until FM3 89.3 MHz flashes twice on the digital display. The station has now been preset

How to recall the preset stations

A station preset at No. 5 position on the FM2 band, and this station is desired, then push the BAND button repeatedly until FM2 appears on the digital readout, and then push the No. 5 button.

Manual Tune Up or Down

Push either key to move the channel selection up or down.

Auto search for an available station

Push to auto search or the cluster or buttons on the remote for an available station at a lower or higher frequency near the current station. When this function is selected, the unit will stay at the selected station until another function is selected.



Auto Seek through all the ranges of the FM or AM bands

Press the FAST RWD button, The unit will select auto scan function. And will automatically preset any available station in order, from low to high until all the preset positions have been filed. When a station is found, it will be stored in the unit.

Weather Band Reception

Press the [BAND] button to select the Weather Band. Once the unit is set on the Weather Band function, it will automatically search for an available station among the 7 preset US Weather Bureau frequencies. When the signal is not strong enough to receive the last weather band station, the unit will continue search for another weather band station. The users can also manually select a weather band station by pressing any of the 1-7 preset numbers frequencies.



It is important to understand what is shown on the digital display:

1. Displays the disc track or chapter (As shown the disc is on the tenth track or chapter).
2. Displays the hours the individual song, program or video has been playing.
3. Displays the minutes the individual song, program or video has been playing.
4. Displays the seconds the individual song, program or video has been playing.



To Load a Disc

There are several ways to select and load a disc into the ZX600. If you have left a disc in the unit you will have to press FUNCTION on the front panel until DISC shows on the display. If you are using the remote, press the DISC button. Either of these options will start the disc playing.

Another way to play a disc is to insert it into the slot. The unit will switch to disc by itself.

CAUTION: If the disc won't load into the slot DON'T force it. You will damage the loader, the disc or both (You just might find the disc you thought you lost last week).

Eject a Disc

Regardless of which function is playing, if the EJECT button on the front panel or the remote control is pushed, the unit will stop playing and eject the disc. The unit will keep the disc in the slot with EJECT showing on the Digital Display. If there is no disc inside the unit, a disc placed in the slot will be taken inside automatically with LOADING showing on the Digital Display.

REMARK:


When the unit ejects a disc and the disc isn't removed after 1 minute, the unit will automatically reload the disc. This feature protects the disc from being dropped and damaged.

Play / Pause

Normally, when the unit accepts a disc with no Playback Control, The unit will play the disc from the beginning. When a Playback Control exists, the user needs to push the Play button to start to play the disc. If the user pushes this button again, the unit will pause the disc. To release Pause, push this button again, and play will continue.

Stop

When the unit is playing, push the STOP button to stop playing the disc.

Fast Forward / Fast Reverse

Regardless of whether you use Fast Forward or Fast Reverse,(during DVD mode) there are 6 different speeds to select from: 1X_2X_4X_8X_16X_20X To select a normal speed, push the PLAY button. The unit will immediately play the disc at a normal speed. On the unit the PLAY button must be pressed a second time to Play from Pause

Previous / Next

Pushing the Previous button, the unit will play the disc from the beginning of the previous track;

Pushing the Next button, the unit will play the disc from the beginning of the next track.

SETUP:

Press the SETUP button on the unit when the unit is in the Disc player mode. The screen will display the system setting menu. Press or button on the unit can turn MENU page.

To Load USB or SD

USB/SD, as a moving memory set, it can recorded these document: MP3, WMA, JPEG and MPEG. If you push the compatible USB/SD into the socket of the machine, it can auto playing all kind Of the document that USB/SD recorded.

NOTE :

1. Because the USB/SD come from different factory capable, and all factories can't work on a same technology standard, so the machine can't playing the USB/SD correctly.
2. Before you push off the USB/SD from the machine, press the "STOP" had better.

Because of variations in 3rd party recording methods some discs may not play on this unit.

CD Mode: Use this button to eject the CD from the unit.

DISC

Similar to the Function button on the main unit. This button selects the CD/DVD. When inserting a DC/DVD the unit will automatically start the play function.

This button selects the Radio.

USB/SD

USB/SD

Press to select USB or SD.



INPUT

Press to select AU1, AU2, AV1 or Av2.



BAND

Once the radio is selected, this button allows you to select FM1, FM2, FM3, AM1, AM2 or the Weatherband.




A, B and C Rooms

Turns sound on or off in corresponding rooms A, B or C.



0-9 NUMBERS



Radio: Press to select preset stations. For details on setting preset stations, please see page 4.

Disc: Selects different tracks on CD and different chapters on DVD.

Radio: N/A.

Disc: Press the 100+ area on the "0" button to select tracks numbered higher than 100 on MP3s.



RETURN/SUB-T

DVD Only - Returns to previously selected tracks. Press it for about 3 seconds to view the status of the DVD or CD title.



REPEAT

Press once to repeat last CD/WMA track selected. Pressing twice repeats all for continuing play. Press again to turn off.



ZOOM

DVD Only - Pressing ZOOM will alternate between enlarged picture 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X and reduced picture 1/2X, 1/3X, 1/4X.



AUDIO

DVD Only - Adjusts the surround sound mode as well as selects the language. Must be set before play.



Cluster Buttons

Press the appropriate button to move around any menus that are selected on screen. Center button is the "select" button.



VOLUME UP/DOWN

Press to increase or decrease the sound volume.



MUTE/BC

Turn the sound off or on with this single button. Works on all Rooms where the sound is being played. Pressing the BC button for about 5 seconds defaults to default settings.



Have the same function as Cluster Buttons ▲ ▼.



SETUP

Press for DVD setup menu.



MENU/DISPLAY

DVD Only - Selects upper menu. Press the button for about 3 seconds to view the status of the DVD or CD that is currently playing.



SOUND

Menu controls include Volume, Bass, Treble balance, EQ and time. Controls can be modified differently for each room.



SLOW

Slows on-screen action in DVD.



STOP

Press to stop play.



PLAY/PAUSE

Press to play press again to pause play.

FAST REVERSE/FORWARD

Press to select different levels of Fast Reverse or Forward. Press play to resume selection.

Remote Control Operation

Power

Press "POWER" button to turn On/Off the power.

EJECT:To Eject Disc From Unit

When the unit is in Disc Play mode, if the EJECT button on the front panel or the remote control is pushed. If there is no disc inside the unit, a disc placed in the slot will be taken inside automatically with LOAD showing on the Digital Display. When the unit ejects a disc and the disc isn't removed after 1 minute, the unit will automatically reload the disc.

Band

Push the "BAND" or "RADIO" button and the unit switches to Radio immedintely. During radio mode, press "RADIO" again to switch receiving band.

Number Buttons

— During radio mode, you can select one of the 9 stored stations on each hand by pressing any one of the **number button 1~9**.

— During the playing mode, you can select any track directly by using **number button (0~100+)**.

For example, if you need the twenty-five track, you can first press button 2 and then press button 5, the corresponding tarck (15)th will be automation played.

Program

— During **CD, VCD** mode, you can set the program order to play, you can follow the steps as below:

Press "PROGAM" button, and the LCD displays programming **P00:00**. You can set the program order to play them by using **(0~10+)** number button, and then press "PLAY/PAUSE" to play.

Note:

① *Program doesn't function in playing MP3.*

② *CD Only*: Allows you to re-arrange the playback order of individual tracks differently from the order on the original disc.
TV screen shot shown.



③ *If there are mistakes in programs, you can press 'PROGAM' button again, then press 'PROGAM' button to play in order.*

Remote Control Operation

Repeat

— During DVD mode, firstly Press "REPEAT" to repeat the current track being played; Press it again to repeat playing all the tracks. The third press it to Off (LCD will display different designs)

— During CD, MP3, VCD mode, firstly press "REPEAT" to repeat the current track being played; press it again to cancel the repeating functional.

Note: In VCD, MP3, CD mode, The initial procedure is repeat playing all the tracks.

Note: In radiomode, Press "REPEAT" to scan each stored station 10 seconds respectively which stored in Number Buttons.

ZOOM KEY

— In DVD, VCD playing mode, press (ZOOM) key once for 2x Mode, twice for 3x Mode. Third time for 4x Mode, forthly time for 1/2x. Five times for 1/3x, six times for 1/4x, seven times to off .

Note: NO ZOOM function CD/MP3 playing mode.

Volume Increasing/Decreasing

Press "VOL+" or "VOL-" button to increase or decrease the volume level respectively.

Mute Button

Press "MUTE" button to cut down the sound of all rooms a, b, or c output, press it once more to resume the previous sound level.

MENU: Playing PBC

— During VCD mode only, when pressing "MENU" button at the

first time, **PBC** playback starts and the menu of entire disc appears on the television. And then you can select your favorite track by using number button (0~100+) number button. When a track is playing, you can press "RETURN" button to return to the menu if you want to stop to select other tracks. To cancel PBC playing, press "MENU" button again.

Menu selector

Press "⬅️ ➡️ ⏪ ⏩" button to select your desired menu, then press "ENTER" or press the play button "PLAY/PAUSE" to confirm.

Note: ① This function works in main menu mode only. refer to page 13 .



Sound: Selector (RADIO MODE)

— Repeatedly press "SOUND" button to select the desired mode in the following order:



Note: After selecting your desired mode, you can adjust the current mode being displayed by using VOL KNOB.

Time setting: Switch to "Time" mode. Push and hold "SOUND" button longer than 3 seconds then press VOL+ or VOL- to set time.

Remote Control Operation

Display on screen display

— During CD, VCD, DVD mode, press "DISPLAY" button. The display Shows single track elapsed time, single track left time or entire disc left time, and the track being played and the amount of the whole disc

Note: During MP3 mode, only single track elapsed time is displayed in OSD mode.

SLOW:(SLOW REVERSE/SLOW ADVANCE KEY)

— In DVD playing mode, press "SLOW" key once for 2x slow advance, twice for 3x slow advance, third for 4x slow advance, fourth for 5x slow reverse, fifth for 6x slow reverse, sixth for 7x slow reverse, seventh for normal player.

— In VCD playing mode, press "SLOW" key once for 1x slow advance, twice for 2x slow advance, third for 3x slow advance, press "PLAY" key to cancel slow reverse /Slow advance function.

Note: In MP3 and CD, it is not the function.

Stop: Stop the Playback

— In DVD,VCD,CD mode,press "STOP" button to suspend the playback and "PRE-STOP" shown on TV, press it again to stop the playback.


PLAY/PAUSE

Press "PLAY/PAUSE" button to suspend the playback of CD, MP3, VCD, DVD. Press it again to return to normal playback mode.

Tuning>Selecting Tracks /FastRewind/Forward

— During radio mode, continuously press "FB" or "FF" button, the radio will automatically search a station downward or upward respectively until it finds a station.

Disc: Regardless of whether you use Fast Forward or Fast Reverse, there are 6 different speeds to select from: 1X, 2X, 4X, 8X, 16X, 20X To select a normal speed, push the PLAY button. The unit will immediately play the disc at a normal speed.



PREVIOUS/NEXT

Pushing the Previous button, the unit will play the disc from the beginning of the previous track. Pushing the Next button, the unit will play the disc from the beginning of the next track.





To change the password, you will be prompted for the old password, then be prompted for a new, (4-digit number is available password)



the system can display Kid to Audit 8 options, when selecting Rating

the system can display Chinese,English,Japan, French,Spanish,Portguese,German and Latin for options when selecting menu lang (Shown as picture)



Please select exit option for exit.

AUDIO SETUP:audio out,key, exit setup
the system can display spdif/off,spdif/raw, spdif/pcm,when selecting audio out. (Shown as picture)



It can adjust the size when selecting key (Shown as picture)



VIDEO SETUP:brightness,contrast,hue saturation,sharpness,exit setup

It can adjust the brightness when selecting Brightness (Shown as picture)



It can adjust the contrast when selecting contrast(Shown as picture)

Simple Troubleshooting Guide

Problem	Cause/Solution
No power	★ Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown, replace with the proper value if necessary.
Some errors occur in the LCD or no function when pressing the button.	★ Start the machine again.
Poor effect on receiving a station.	★ Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended or broken: if broken, Replace the antenna with a new one. ★ The broadcasting signal is too weak. ★ The antenna is poorly grounded, check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded at its mounting location.
Disc cannot be loaded.	★ Disc is loaded in the mechanism.
No picture.	★ The Video line from main unit to the TV is not connected properly.
Disc error appears	★ Improper setting of the color system. Set the color system to "PAL" or "NTSC", according to the connected television. ★ The Disc is dirty or damaged..
When there is no color on video	★ Please restart the machine.

★ Note: If any of the problem persist after check list had been made, consult your nearest service dealer.
Never attempt to disassemble your unit by yourself.

Warning

Please use only components recommended by factory when replacement is necessary. Please turn unit off when not in use. Use a dry, soft cloth to clean face with the system turned off.

PRECAUTION

Moisture may cause lens of loader in this unit to malfunction. To remedy the problem, turn unit on eject disc, and run for 1-2 hours to vaporize moisture inside the unit. Do not repeatedly turn unit off and on. After turning unit off, wait 10 seconds before turning on again. Do not use broken, scratched, or twisted discs in player. This could result in damage to the unit. Use only 5" 12cm discs in this unit.

INPUT Options

Press to select INPUT 1 (Audio Video). This allows units such as Satellite TV, Digital Cameras, VCRs and other audio video equipment to be connected to the ZX500. It may also be used to select the "optional" iPod wall plate or other multi-input wall plates that may be installed in select coaches and trailers.

Press to select INPUT 2 (Audio Only). This allows MP3 players and other audio inputs to be connected to the ZX500. It may also control the "optional" XM Radio wall plate or other multi-input wall plates.

XM Satellite Radio

ZW100 XM WALL PLATE

The ZW100 Wall Plate is an optional plate to be used with the Delphi SKY-Fi or SKY-Fi II XM Radio Satellite Receivers.

INSERTING

To insert the receiver, press the center of the cradle as indicated at right. The cradle will tilt forward so that the satellite receiver can be loaded. Once in the cradle, push the receiver downward to make a positive connection. Do this gently so that no damage to the connections occur.

Push the top of the satellite receiver and cradle back into the wall plate until it locks into place. Use the FUNCTION BUTTON on the ZX500's Main Unit and select INPUT 2 to listen to XM Radio through your entertainment system.

REMOVAL

ZW150 iPOD WALL PLATE

The ZW150 Wall Plate is an optional plate that can be used with any "dockable" iPod Audio or Video player.

INSERTING

With your iPod mounted in the carrier push the cradle as shown at left and it will tilt forward so that the iPod player with the carrier can be loaded.


Once in the cradle push downward to make a positive connection. Do this gently so that no damage to the connections occur.




This wall plate is used for Games and other Audio/Video inputs. This plate is connected to INPUT 1 on the ZX500. To use this plate, press the FUNCTION button on the radio panel until Input 1 shows in the display. When using the remote control press the INPUT button. Input 1 will be shown in the display.

Game consoles should be connected to the left side of the plate (IN/AV1). There is a right and left channel for audio and a video connection. Standard audio video cables with RCA male connectors can be used. Using the select switch on the plate select A/V1 to play games.

VCR's, cameras, cable boxes or other audio video inputs can be connected to the right side of the plate (IN/AV2). Move the select switch to A/V2 (to the right) when using this input.



TYPICAL WALL PLATE WIRING HOOKUP





For MP3 players or TV audio Use the right side connections and select MP3/TV on the switch. If the XM Satellite radio wall plate or the iPod wall plate is installed in your trailer or coach with this plate you must select XM/iPod on the switch for them to operate.
