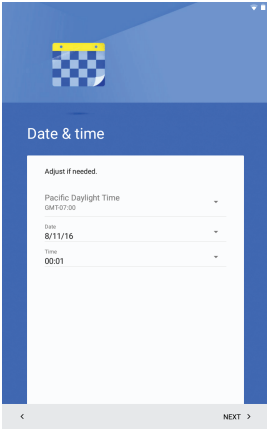

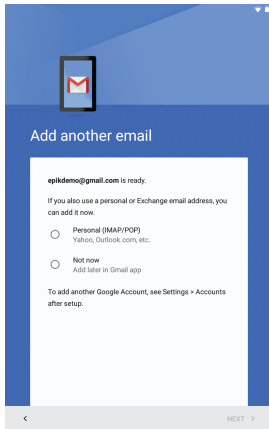
- 1 Enter your correct Date & Time and tap on "Next"

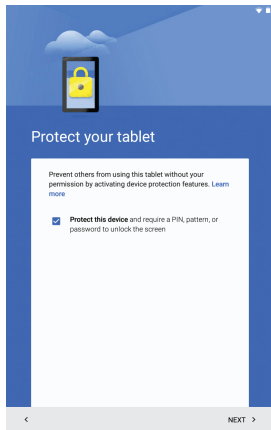

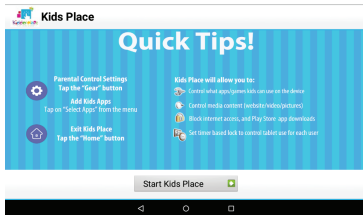
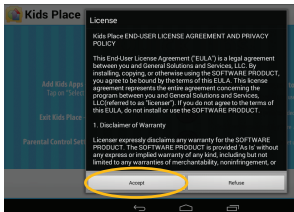
