## GENERAL INFORMATION

---

### Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *Tech Vision Electronics Ltd.*'s product, model number: *B831 (FCC ID: ZIHB831)* or the "EUT" as referred to in this report is a *GSM Mobile Phone*, which measures approximately: 9.5 cm (L) x 5.5 cm (W) x 2.0 cm (H), rated input voltage: DC 3.7V battery.

*\* All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from production sample serial number: 1104009 (Assigned by BACL, Shenzhen). The EUT was received on 2011-04-27.*

### Objective

This type approval report is prepared on behalf of *Tech Vision Electronics Ltd.* in accordance with Part 2, Subpart J, Part 22 Subpart H, and Part 24 Subpart E of the Federal Communication Commissions rules.

The objective is to determine compliance with FCC rules for output power, modulation characteristic, occupied bandwidth, and spurious emission at antenna terminal, spurious radiated emission, frequency stability, band edge and radiated margin.

### Test Methodology

All tests and measurements indicated in this document were performed in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations Title 47 Part 2, Sub-part J as well as the following parts:

Part 22 Subpart H - Public Mobile Services  
Part 24 Subpart E - Personal Communication Services

Applicable Standards: TIA/EIA 603-C, ANSI C63.4-2009.

All radiated and conducted emissions measurements were performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 meters.

The uncertainty of any RF tests which are conducted met the measurement is  $\pm 0.96$  dB, the uncertainty of any radiation emission measurement is  $\pm 4.0$  dB.

### Test Facility

The Test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp.(Shenzhen) to collect test data is located in the 6/F, the 3rd Phase of WanLi Industrial Building, ShiHua Road, FuTian Free Trade Zone Shenzhen, Guangdong, China.

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Shenzhen) has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on December 06, 2010. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2009.

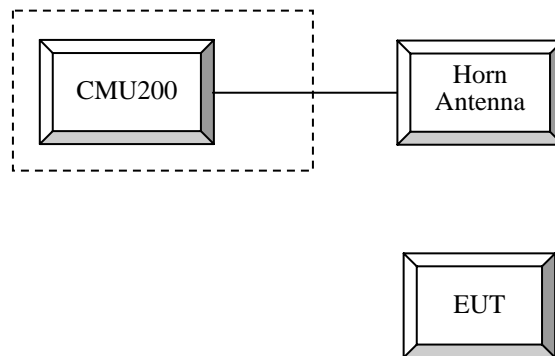

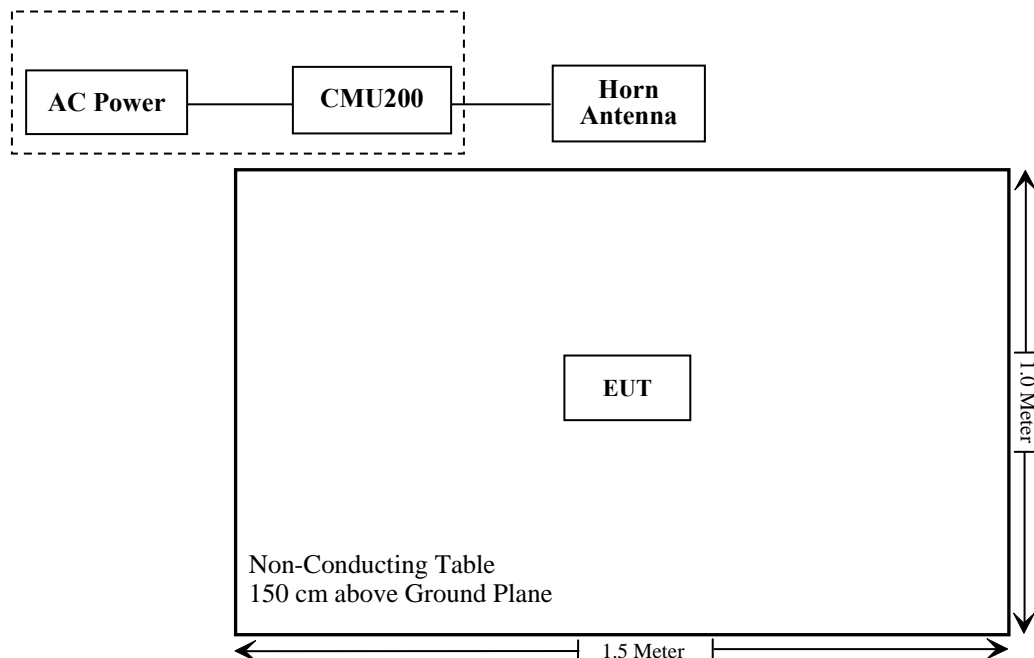

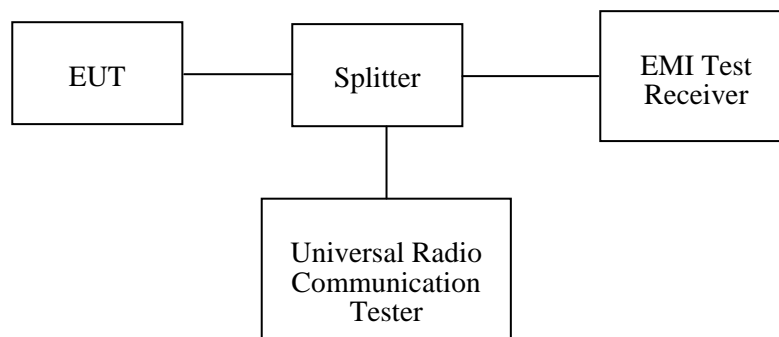

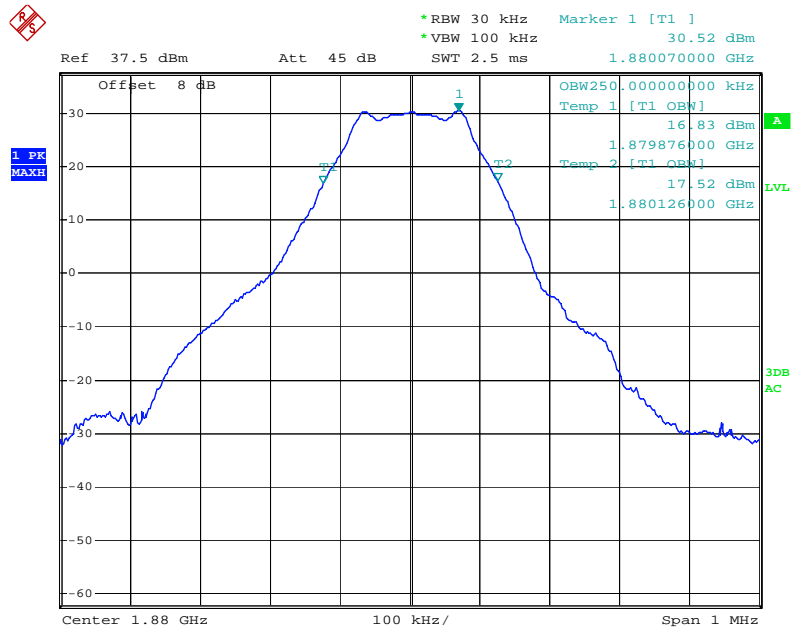
## 26 dB Occupied Bandwidth

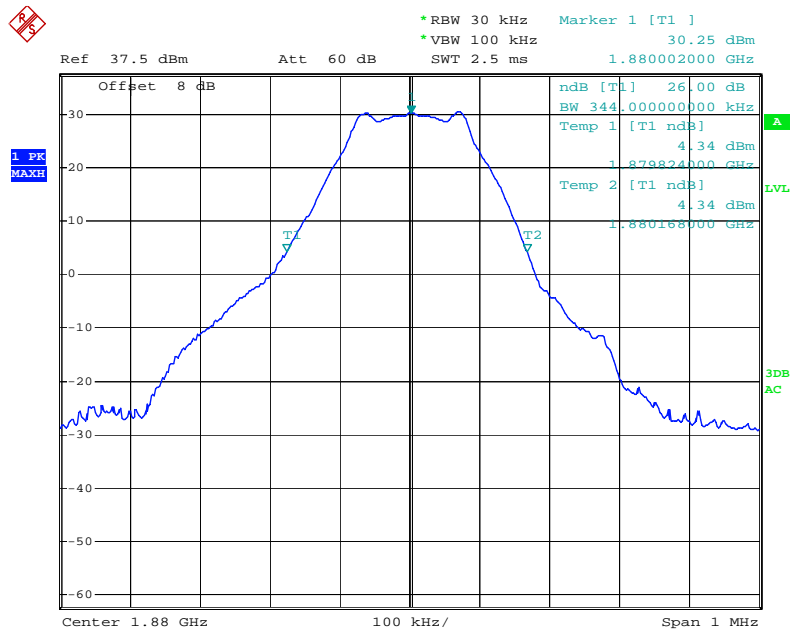

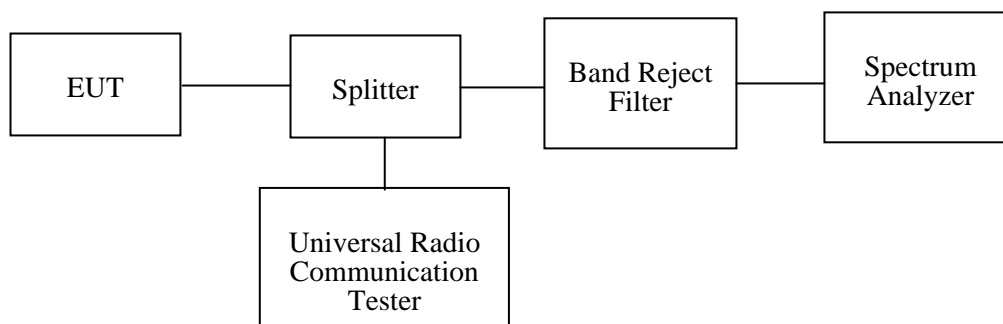

The spectrum was to be investigated to the tenth harmonics of the highest fundamental frequency as specified in § 2.1051.

### Test Procedure

The RF output of the transceiver was connected to a spectrum analyzer and simulator through appropriate attenuation. The resolution bandwidth of the spectrum analyzer was set at 100 kHz. Sufficient scans were taken to show any out of band emissions up to 10<sup>th</sup> harmonic.

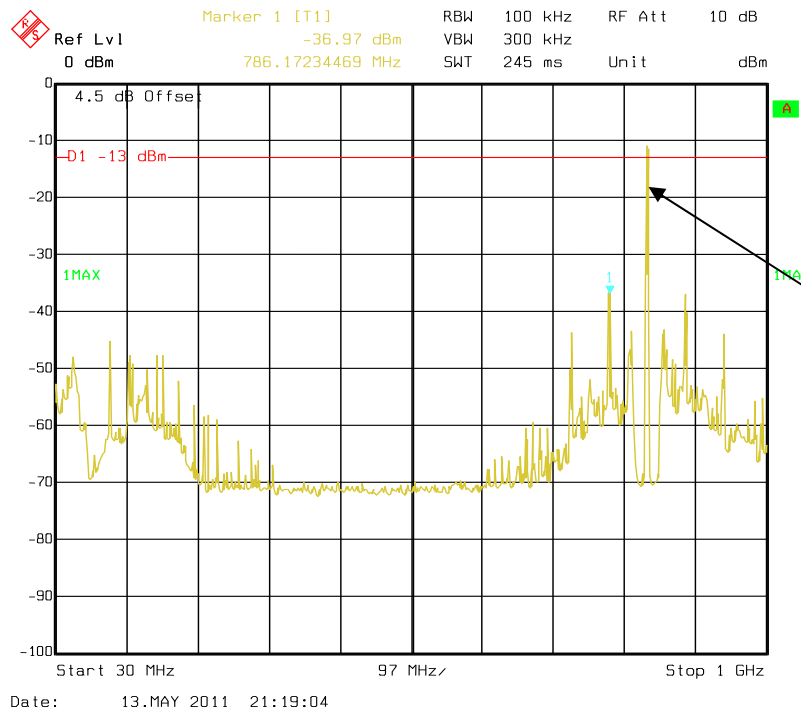

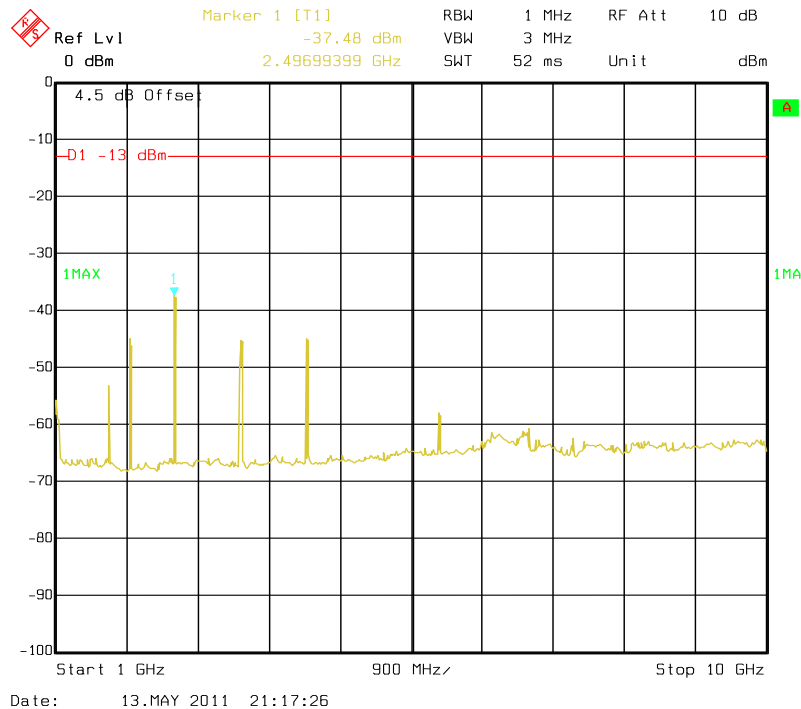

## 30 – 1000 MHz - Middle Channel



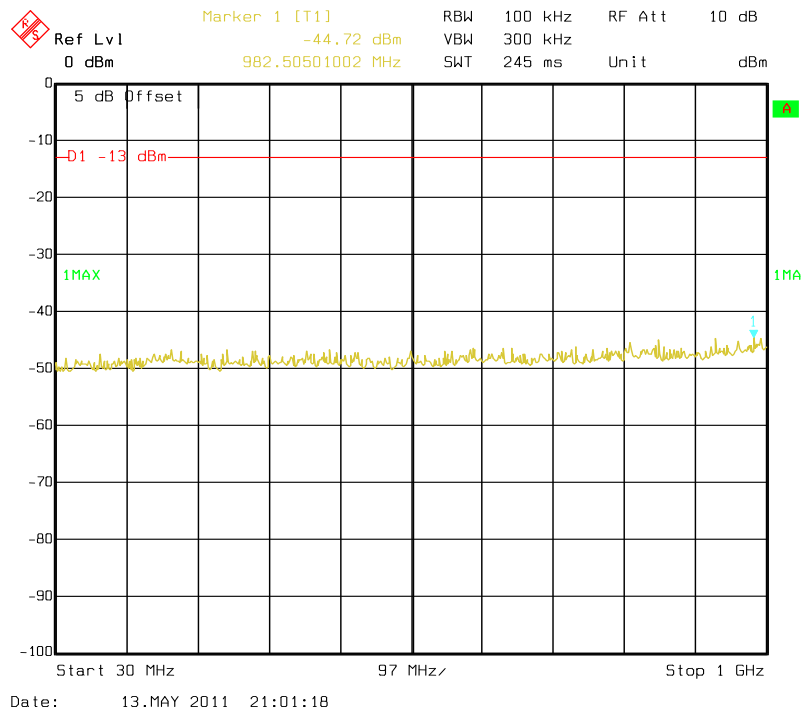
Fundamental test with Band Reject Filter

## 1 – 10 GHz - Middle Channel

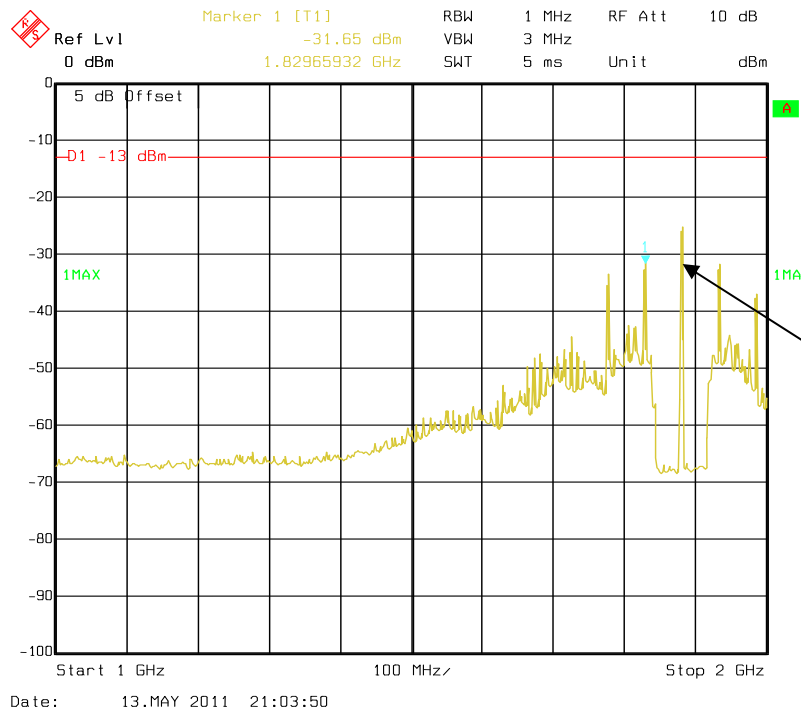

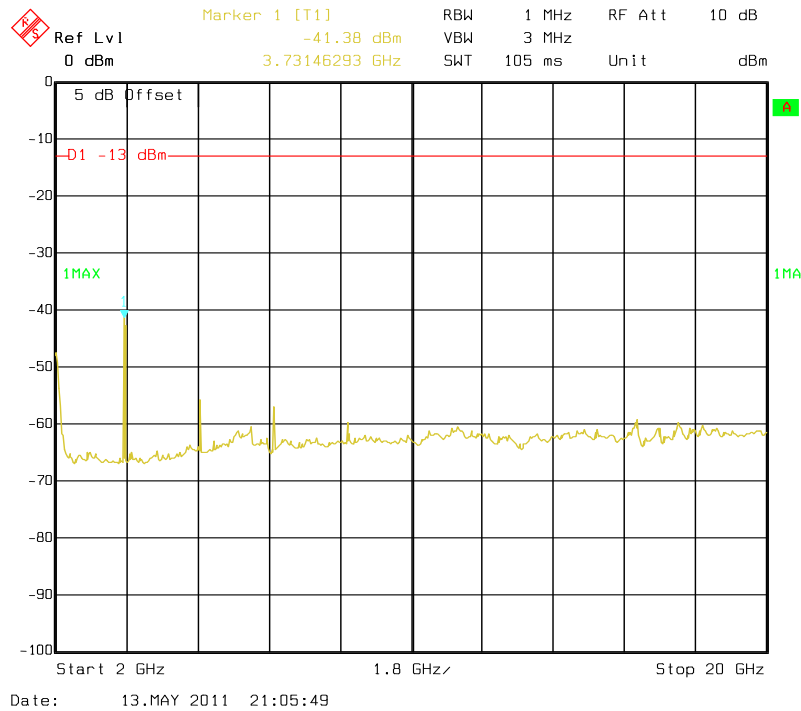


## 1 - 2 GHz - Middle Channel

### Applicable Standards

FCC §2.1053, §22.917 and §24.238.

### Test Procedure

The transmitter was placed on a wooden turntable, and it was transmitting into a non-radiating load which was also placed on the turntable.

The measurement antenna was placed at a distance of 3 meters from the EUT. During the tests, the antenna height and polarization as well as EUT azimuth were varied in order to identify the maximum level of emissions from the EUT. The test was performed by placing the EUT on 3-orthogonal axis.

The frequency range up to tenth harmonic of the fundamental frequency was investigated.

Remove the EUT and replace it with substitution antenna. A signal generator was connected to the substitution antenna by a non-radiating cable. The absolute levels of the spurious emissions were measured by the substitution.

Spurious emissions in dB =  $10 \lg (\text{TXpwr in Watts}/0.001)$  – the absolute level

Spurious attenuation limit in dB =  $43 + 10 \text{Log}_{10} (\text{power out in Watts})$

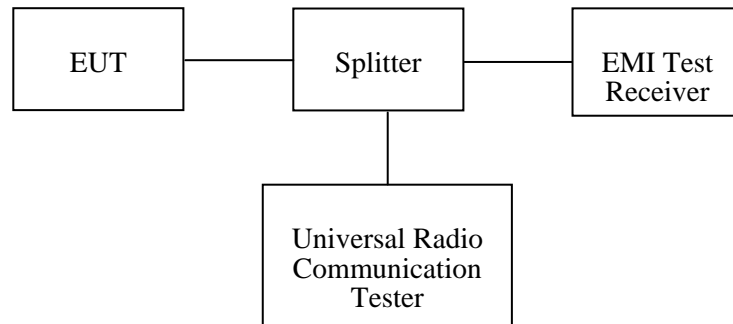

The center of the spectrum analyzer was set to block edge frequency, RBW set to 10 kHz.

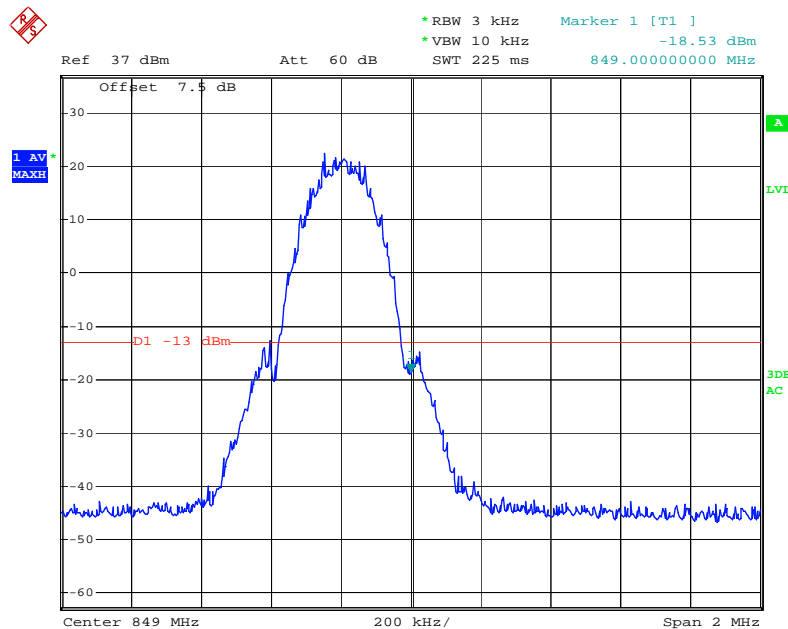

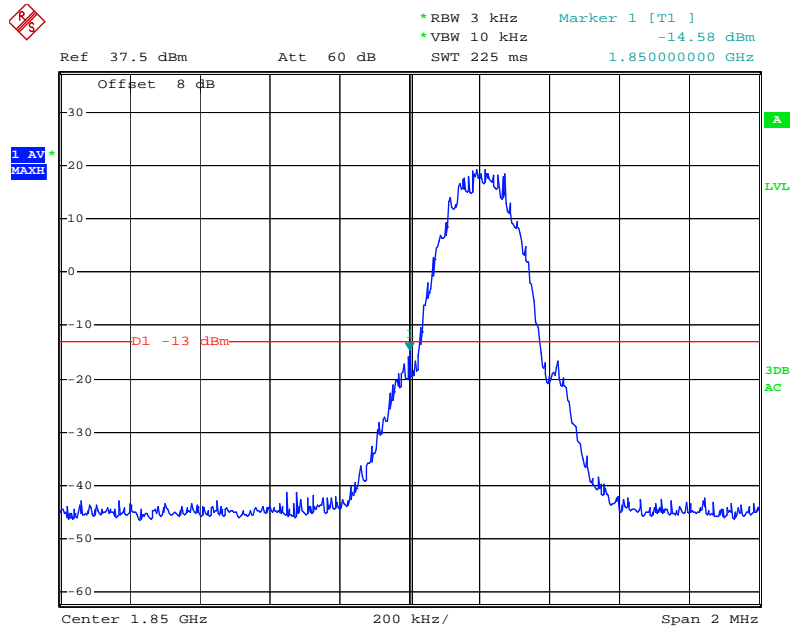

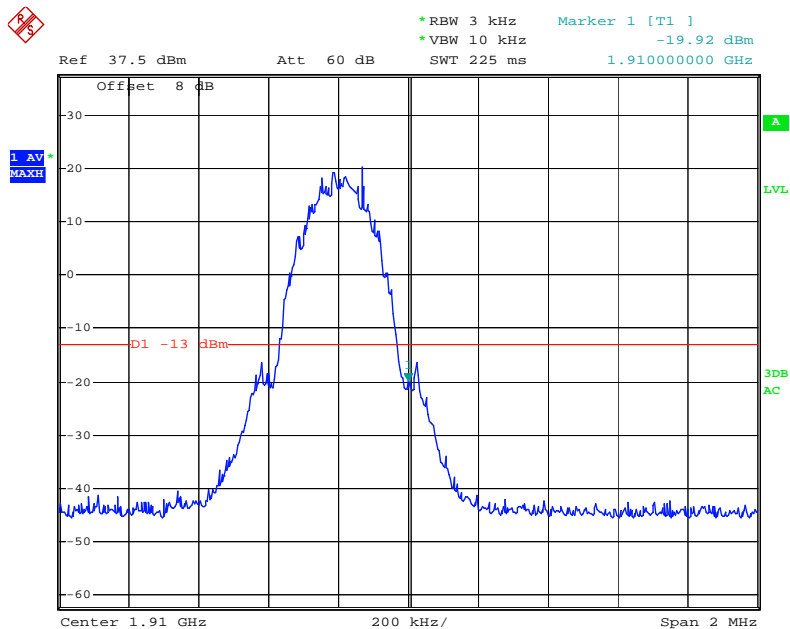

## FCC §2.1055, §22.355 & §24.235 - FREQUENCY STABILITY

### Applicable Standards

FCC §2.1055 (a), §2.1055 (d), §22.355, §24.235

According to §22.355, the carrier frequency of each transmitter in the Public Mobile Services must be maintained within the tolerances given in Table below:

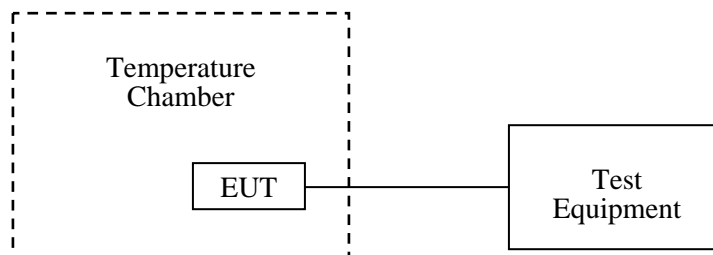
According to FCC §24.235, the frequency stability shall be sufficient to ensure that the fundamental emissions stays within the authorized frequency block.

### Test Procedure

**Frequency Stability vs. Temperature:** The equipment under test was connected to an external DC power supply and the RF output was connected to communication test set via feed-through attenuators. The EUT was placed inside the temperature chamber. The DC leads and RF output cable exited the chamber through an opening made for the purpose.

After the temperature stabilized for approximately 20 minutes, the frequency output was recorded from the communication test set.

**Frequency Stability vs. Voltage:** An external variable DC power supply was connected to the battery terminals of the equipment under test. The voltage was set to 115% of the nominal value and was then decreased until the transmitter light no longer illuminated; i.e., the battery end point. The output frequency was recorded for each battery voltage.
