The bandwidth at 20dB down from the highest inband spectral density is measured with a spectrum analyzer connected to the antenna terminal, while EUT is operating in transmission mode at the appropriate frequencies.  
After the trace being stable, Use the marker-to-peak function to measure 20 dB down both sides of the intentional emission.

- 1) In the frequency range of 9 kHz to 30 MHz, magnetic field is measured with Loop Antenna. The Test Antenna is positioned with its plane vertical at 1m distance from the EUT. The center of the Loop Test Antenna is 1m above the ground. During the measurement the Loop Test Antenna rotates about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth about the EUT.
- 2) In the frequency range above 30 MHz, Bi-Log Test Antenna(30 MHz to 1 GHz) and Horn Test Antenna(above 1 GHz) are used. Test Antenna is 3m away from the EUT. Test Antenna height is carried from 1m to 4m above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength.
