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

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INTRODUCTION 1.0

1.1 Scope

Measurement and determination of electromagnetic emissions (EMC) of radio frequency devices including intentional and/or unintentional radiators for compliance with the technical rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and the Industry Canada Certification and Engineering Bureau.

PCTEST Test Location 1.2




Figure 1-1. Map of the Greater Baltimore and Metropolitan Washington, D.C. area

The map below shows the location of the PCTEST LABORATORY, its proximity to the FCC Laboratory, the Columbia vicinity, the Baltimore-Washington Internt'l (BWI) airport, the city of Baltimore and the Washington, DC area. (See Figure 1-1).

These measurement tests were conducted at the PCTEST Engineering Laboratory, Inc. facility in New Concept Business Park, Guilford Industrial Park, Columbia, Maryland. The site address is 6660-B Dobbin Road, Columbia, MD 21045. The test site is one of the highest points in the Columbia area with an elevation of 390 feet above mean sea level. The site coordinates are 39° 11'15" N latitude and 76° 49'38" W longitude. The facility is 1.5 miles North of the FCC laboratory, and the ambient signal and ambient signal strength are approximately equal to those of the FCC laboratory. There are no FM or TV transmitters within 15 miles of the site. The detailed description of the measurement facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of § 2.948 according to ANSI C63.4-2009 on January 10, 2012.

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PRODUCT INFORMATION 2.0

2.1 **Equipment Description**

The Equipment Under Test (EUT) is the LGE Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFD959. The test data contained in this report pertains only to the emissions due to the EUT's UNII transmitter.

2.2 **Device Capabilities**

This device contains the following capabilities:

850/1900 GSM/GPRS/EDGE, 850/1700/1900 WCDMA/HSPA, Band 2 (5, 10, 15, and 20MHz BW), 4 (5, 10, 15, and 20MHz BW), and 17 (5 and 10MHz BW) LTE, 802.11a/b/g/n/ac WLAN (DTS/NII), Bluetooth (1x,EDR, LE), NFC

Note: 5GHz WLAN (DTS/NII) operation is possible in 20MHz, 40MHz, and 80MHz channel bandwidths. The maximum achievable duty cycles for all modes were determined based on measurements performed on a spectrum analyzer in zero-span mode with RBW = 8MHz, VBW = 50MHz, and detector = peak per the guidance of Section B)2)b) of KDB 789033. The RBW and VBW were both greater than 50/T, where T is the minimum transmission duration, and the number of sweep points across T was greater than 100. The duty cycles are as follows:

- 802.11a/n 20MHz Bandwidth 95.38 %
- 802.11n 40MHz Bandwidth 91.42 %
- 802.11ac 80MHz Bandwidth 83.03 %

2.3 **Test Configuration**

The LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFD959 was tested per the guidance of KDB 789033. ANSI C63.10-2009 was used to reference the appropriate EUT setup for radiated spurious emissions testing and AC line conducted testing. U-NII procedures and limits were applied for operations in the frequency band from 5.725-5.850 GHz in accordance with KDB 644545 D02 v01 to demonstrate compliance with 15.247 requirements. See Sections 6.12, 3.3, and 6.1 of this test report for a description of the AC line conducted emissions, radiated emissions, and antenna port conducted emissions test setups, respectively.

2.4 **EMI Suppression Device(s)/Modifications**

No EMI suppression device(s) were added and/or no modifications were made during testing.

2.5 **Labeling Requirements**

Per 2.1074 & 15.19; Docket 95-19

The label shall be permanently affixed at a conspicuous location on the device; instruction manual or pamphlet supplied to the user and be readily visible to the purchaser at the time of purchase. However, when the device is so small wherein placement of the label with specified statement is not practical, only the trade name and FCC ID must be displayed on the device per Section 15.19(a)(5). 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DESCRIPTION OF TEST 3.0

3.1 **Evaluation Procedure**

The measurement procedures described in the American National Standard for Testing Unlicensed Wireless Devices (ANSI C63.10-2009) and the guidance provided in KDB 789033 v01r03 were used in the measurement of LGE Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFD959.




Figure 3-1. Shielded **Enclosure Line-Conducted Test Facility**




Figure 3-2. Line **Conducted Emission Test Set-Up**




Figure 3-3. Wooden Table & Bonded LISNs




Figure 3-4. LISN Schematic Diagram

The line-conducted facility is located inside a 16'x20'x10' shielded enclosure, manufactured by Ray Proof Series 81 (see Figure 3-1). The shielding effectiveness of the shielded room is in accordance with MIL-Std-285 or NSA 65-5. A 1m x 1.5m wooden table 80cm high is placed 40cm away from the vertical wall and 1.5m away from the sidewall of the shielded room (see Figure 3-2). Two 10kHz-30MHz, 50Ω/50μH Line-Impedance Stabilization Networks (LISNs) are bonded to the shielded room (see Figure 3-3). Power to the LISNs are filtered by a high-current high-insertion loss Ray Proof power line filter (100dB 14Hz-10GHz). The purpose of the filter is to attenuate ambient signal interference and this filter is also bonded to the shielded enclosure. All electrical cables are shielded by braided tinned copper zipper tubing with an inner diameter of ½".

The EUT is powered from one LISN and the support equipment is powered from the second LISN. If the EUT is a DC-powered device, power will be derived from the source power supply it normally will be powered from and this supply line(s) will be connected to the Solar LISN. The LISN schematic diagram is shown (see Figure 3-4). All interconnecting cables more than 1 meter were shortened to a 1 meter length by non-inductive bundling (serpentine fashion) and draped over the back edge of the test table. All cables were at least 40cm above the horizontal reference groundplane. Power cables for support equipment were routed down to the second LISN while ensuring that that cables were not draped over the second LISN.

Sufficient time for the EUT, support equipment, and test equipment was allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The RF output of the LISN was connected to the spectrum analyzer and exploratory measurements were made to determine the frequencies producing the maximum emission from the EUT. The spectrum was scanned from 150kHz to 30MHz with a spectrum analyzer. The detector function was set to peak mode for exploratory measurements. The bandwidth of the analyzer was set to 10kHz. The EUT, support equipment, and interconnecting cables were arranged and manipulated to maximize each emission emission. Each emission was maximized by varying: power lines, the mode of operation or resolution, clock or data exchange speed, scrolling H pattern to the EUT and/or support equipment, and powering the monitor from the floor mounted outlet box and the computer aux AC outlet, if applicable; whichever determined the worst-case emission. Once the worst case emissions have been identified, the one EUT cable configuration/arrangement and mode of operation that produced these emissions is used for final measurements on the same test site. The analyzer is set to CISPR quasi-peak and average detectors with a 9kHz bandwidth for final measurements. Each emission reported was calibrated using a signal generator.

Line conducted emissions test results are shown in Section 6.12. Automated test software was used to perform the AC line conducted emissions testing. Automated measurement software utilized is the PCTEST Conduction Automatic Measurement, Version 2.7.

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Radiated Emissions

The radiated test facilities consisted of an indoor semi-anechoic chamber used for exploratory measurements and an open area test site (OATS) used for final measurements. For all measurements, the spectrum was scanned through all EUT azimuths and from 1 to 4 meter receive antenna height using a broadband antenna from 30MHz up to the upper frequency shown in 15.33(b)(1) depending on the highest frequency generated or used in the device or on which the device operates or tunes. For frequencies higher than the upper frequency range of the broadband antenna used for testing, linearly polarized double ridge horn antennas were used. For frequencies below 30MHz, a calibrated loop antenna was used.




Figure 3-7. Turntable and **System Setup**

Exploratory measurements were performed at 1 meter test distance inside the semi-anechoic chamber using broadband antennas, broadband amplifiers, and spectrum analyzers to determine the frequencies producing the maximum emissions. Sufficient time for the EUT. support equipment, and test equipment was allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The test set-up was placed on top of a 0.8 meter high non-metallic 1 x 1.5 meter table (see Figure 3-7). The EUT, support equipment, and interconnecting cables were arranged and manipulated to maximize each emission. Appropriate precaution was taken to ensure that all emissions from the EUT were maximized and investigated. The system configuration, clock speed, mode of operation or video resolution, turntable azimuth, and receive antenna height was noted for each frequency found. To record the exploratory measurements, the analyzers' detector function was set to peak mode and the bandwidth was set to 100kHz.

Final measurements were made on the OATS at 3 meter test range using calibrated, linearly polarized broadband or horn antennas (see Figure 3-5). The measurement area is situated on an 18 meter x 20 meter galvanized 1/2" hardware cloth as the conducting ground plane. This material is sewn together in sections 4 feet wide and 60 feet long. A total of eighteen sections are required to cover the entire measurement area. Sections are laid across the width of the pad, overlapped 1" and sewn and soldered together at intervals of 3" (7.6 cm.) The terrain of the test site is reasonably flat and level. Power and cable to the test site are buried 18" deep into the ground outside the perimeter of the site. An all-weather non-metallic housing is situated on a 2 x 3 meter area adjacent to the measurement area to house the test equipment (see Figure 3-6). The test set-up was again placed on top of the same a 0.8 meter high nonmetallic 1 x 1.5 meter table on the OATS as used for exploratory measurements in the indoor chamber. The test set-up was re-configured to the same setup that was previously determined through exploratory measurements to have produced the worst case emissions. The spectrum analyzer was set to the frequencies found to have caused the highest radiated disturbances with respect to the limit during preliminary radiated measurements. The turntable containing the system was rotated through 360 degrees and the height of the receive antenna was varied 1 to 4 meters and stopped at the azimuth and height producing the maximum emission. Each emission was maximized by changing the orientation of the EUT through three orthogonal planes and changing the polarity of the receive antenna, whichever produced the worst-case emissions. For the EUT positioning, "H" is defined with the EUT lying flat on the test surface, "H2" is defined with the EUT standing up on its side, and "V" is defined with the EUT standing upright. The Theoretical Normalized Site Attenuation Curves for both horizontal and vertical polarization are shown in Figure 3-8.

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ANTENNA REQUIREMENTS 4.0

Excerpt from §15.203 of the FCC Rules/Regulations:

"An intentional radiator antenna shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party can be used with the device. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the provisions of this section."

- The antennas of the Portable Handset are **permanently attached**.
- There are no provisions for connection to an external antenna.

Conclusion:

The LGE Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFD959 unit complies with the requirement of §15.203.

Notes:

- 1) All channels, modes, and modulations/data rates were investigated among all UNII bands. The test results shown in the following sections represent the worst case emissions.
- The analyzer plots shown in this section were all taken with a correction table loaded into the analyzer. The correction table was used to account for the losses of the cables and attenuators used as part of the system to connect the EUT to the analyzer at all frequencies of interest.
- 3) All antenna port conducted emissions testing was performed on a test bench with the antenna port of the EUT connected to the spectrum analyzer through calibrated cables and attenuators.
- 4) For conducted spurious emissions, automated test software was used to measure emissions and capture the corresponding plots necessary to show compliance. The measurement software utilized is PCTEST "UNII Automation", Version 2.2.

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26dB Bandwidth Measurement - 802.11a/n/ac

Test Overview and Limit

The bandwidth at 26dB down from the highest in-band spectral density is measured with a spectrum analyzer connected to the antenna terminal while the EUT is operating at its maximum duty cycle, at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, and at the appropriate frequencies. The spectrum analyzer's bandwidth measurement function is configured to measure the 26dB bandwidth.

The 26dB bandwidth is used to determine the conducted power limits.

Test Procedure Used

KDB 789033 v01r03 - Section C

Test Settings

- 1. The signal analyzers' automatic bandwidth measurement capability was used to perform the 26dB bandwidth measurement. The "X" dB bandwidth parameter was set to X = 26. The automatic bandwidth measurement function also has the capability of simultaneously measuring the 99% occupied bandwidth. The bandwidth measurement was not influenced by any intermediate power nulls in the fundamental emission.
- 2. RBW = approximately 1% of the emission bandwidth
- 3. VBW \geq 3 x RBW
- 4. Detector = Peak
- 5. Trace mode = max hold




Figure 6-1. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup



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Plot 6-1. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 36)




Plot 6-2. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 40)

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Plot 6-3. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 48)




Plot 6-4. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 36)

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Plot 6-5. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 40)




Plot 6-6. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 48)

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
Plot 6-7. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 38)




Plot 6-8. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 46)

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Plot 6-9. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (80MHz BW 802.11ac (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 42)




Plot 6-10. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 52)

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
Plot 6-11. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 56)




Plot 6-12. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 64)

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
Plot 6-13. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 52)




Plot 6-14. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 56)

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
Plot 6-17. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 62)




Plot 6-18. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (80MHz BW 802.11ac (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 58)

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
Plot 6-19. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 100)


Plot 6-22. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 100)


Plot 6-24. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 144)

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
Plot 6-25. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 102)




Plot 6-26. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 110)


Plot 6-28. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (80MHz BW 802.11ac (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 106)


Plot 6-30. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11a (UNII Band 4) - Ch. 149)

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






Plot 6-40 A. 20dB Bandwidth Plot (80MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 58)

Test Overview and Limits

A transmitter antenna terminal of the EUT is connected to the input of an RF pulse power sensor. Measurement is made using a broadband average power meter while the EUT is operating at its maximum duty cycle, at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033, and at the appropriate frequencies.

In the 5.15 – 5.25GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 50mW (16.99dBm) and 4 dBm + $10log_{10}(26dB BW) = 4 dBm + <math>10log_{10}(20.34) = 17.08dBm$.

In the 5.25 – 5.35GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 250mW (23.98dBm) and 11 dBm + $10log_{10}(26dB BW) = 11 dBm + <math>10log_{10}(20.41) = 24.1dBm$.

In the 5.47 - 5.725GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 250mW (23.98dBm) and 11 dBm + $10log_{10}$ (26dB BW) = 11 dBm + $10log_{10}$ (20.14) = 24.04dBm.

In the 5.725 - 5.825GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 1000mW (30dBm) and $17 dBm + 10log_{10}(26dB BW) = 17 dBm + <math>10log_{10}(20.51) = 30.12dBm$.

Test Settings

Average power measurements were performed only when the EUT was transmitting at its maximum power control level using a broadband power meter with a pulse sensor. The power meter implemented triggering and gating capabilities which were set up such that power measurements were recorded only during the ON time of the transmitter. The trace was averaged over 100 traces to obtain the final measured average power.




Figure 6-2. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

Test Notes

In the conducted power tables below, channels that straddle the upper UNII-3 and UNII-4 Band Edge at 5725MHz were evaluated in accordance with requirements of KDB 644545 D01 Section F(3). Accordingly, the power for the portion of the emission occurring within each UNII Band must comply with that particular power limit (i.e. UNII-3 = 250mW, UNII-4 = 1Watt). The powers shown in the tables that follow are the powers for the entire channel bandwidth. It is confirmed that the maximum conducted output power of the entire signal complies with the limits of the respective Band of operation. Therefore the portion of the signal within each band also complies with the limits for that band. Thus those channels comply with Part 15.407(a).




Figure 6-3. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

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Plot 6-41. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 36)




Plot 6-42. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 40)

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
Plot 6-43. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) - Ch. 48)

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
Plot 6-55. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 64)

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
Plot 6-57. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 62)




Plot 6-58. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (80MHz BW 802.11ac (UNII Band 2) - Ch. 58)

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
Plot 6-59. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 100)

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
Plot 6-63. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 3) - Ch. 116)




Plot 6-76. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 4) - Ch. 151)




Figure 6-4. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup




Plot 6-79. Peak Excursion Ratio Plot (802.11a)




Figure 6-5. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

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

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

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

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
