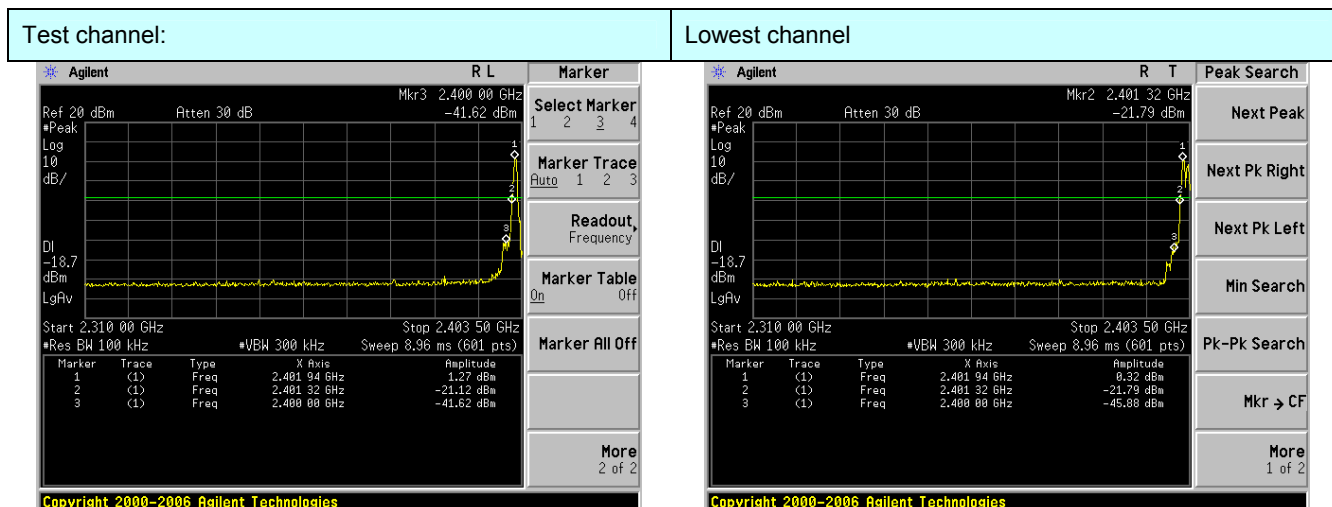

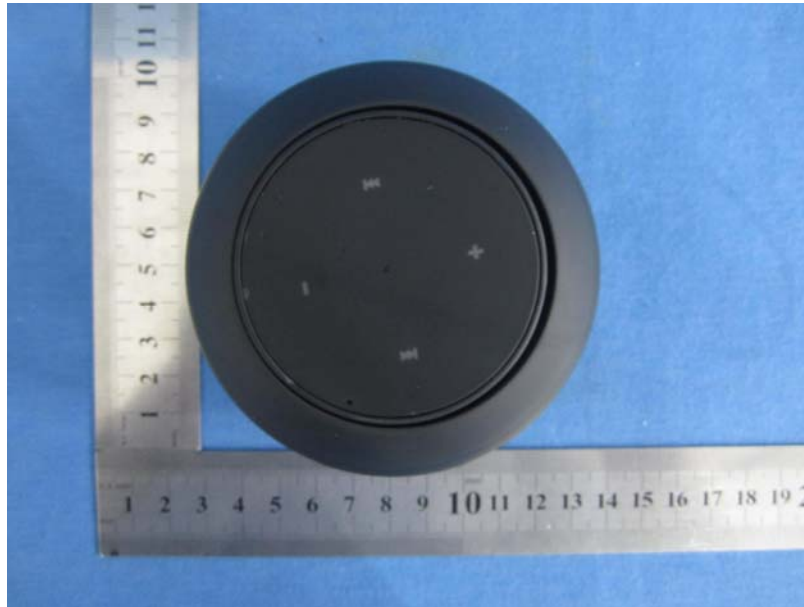
Radiated Emission
