Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *b mobile HK Limited*'s product, model number: *AX690 (FCC ID: ZSW-AX690-AX695)* or the "EUT" in this report was a *Mobile Phone*, which was measured approximately: 136.2 mm (L) x 67.8 mm (W) x 10.0 mm (H), rated with input voltage: DC 3.7 V rechargeable Li-ion battery or DC 5.0V charging from adapter. The highest operating frequency is 1.2 GHz.




Block Diagram of Test Setup

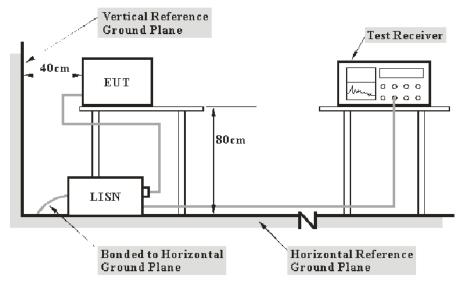



The factors contributing to uncertainties are spectrum analyzer, cable loss, antenna factor calibration, antenna directivity, antenna factor variation with height, antenna phase center variation, antenna factor frequency interpolation, measurement distance variation, site imperfections, mismatch (average), and system repeatability.

The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters chamber test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.4-2009. The specification used was the FCC Part 15.109 Class B limits.

The external I/O cables were draped along the test table and formed a bundle 30 to 40 cm long in the middle.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

The host PC was connected to a 120 VAC/60 Hz power source.

EMI Test Receiver Setup

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 6 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the EMI test receiver was set with the following configurations:

Test Procedure

For the radiated emissions test, the host PC and relevant equipments were connected to AC floor outlet.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

All data was recorded in the Quasi-peak detector mode from 30 MHz to 1 GHz and PK and average detector modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.


