




About File Browser

Use File Browser on the Media Center, view files in the folders on laca SD card or USB devices, also manage them by cut, copy, paste, delete, rename or share.




File Edit

About Settings

Use Settings on the Media Center to configure network connection, set display resolution, and change other settings.

Wi-Fi Networks

Turn Wi-Fi on or off: Choose Wi-Fi, and then turn Wi-Fi on or off.

Join a Wi-Fi network: Select Wi-Fi setting, wait for completion of scanning wireless networks in the field, and then select a network. If necessary, enter the password, and then click Connect.

Join a closed Wi-Fi network: To join a Wi-Fi network that isn't shown in the list of networks, choose Add Network , and then enter the network name. If the network requires a password, click Security, click the type of security the network uses, and enter the password.




Ethernet Configuration

Ethernet Switch On or Off: Choose Ethernet, and then toggle Ethernet on or off.


Join Ethernet network: Choose Ethernet configuration,

If choose Static IP, you will need to input your IP address, Mask, DNS and Default Router, and then click Save.


**Sound**

Choose Digital audio output, and then select PCM or RAW .




Display

Choose Display, and then select 480i, 480p, 576i, 576p, 720p, 1080i or 1080p.




Language & input

Language Setting: enter select language and move up or down the cursor in language list, and select the language you want to use.




Language & input(continue)

In the KEYBOARD & INPUT METHODS, you can select the keyboard you want to use.




Backup & reset

Privacy settings: Choose Factory data reset, and then select **Reset MediaBox**




Date & time

**Upgrade**


Open the APPs, and then click the Upgrade.




Upgrade

You have 2 ways to upgrade the media center, locally or online.

You can upgrade with local upgrade software, before you upgrade, the upgrade package should be copied to the U disk, and then select local upgrade.



After System scanned files, select the file you want to upgrade .



Also you can upgrade you system online, click the online upgrade and find the upgrade package you want to upgrade with and click.



Do not disconnect the power or unplug the equipment storage upgrade package during the upgrade process.
